Part B

1. Activities reflecting the goals and objectives of the institution:

2. New academic programmes initiated (UG and PG):

- i. **CPT Preparatory course:** The College established the CA Guidance Bureau to provide in house guidance to the students who are aspiring for CA. The CPT preparation course was conducted during session 2010-2011. Total 23 students were admitted in the course. Total 18 students appeared for the Common Proficiency Test. 10 students passed CPT examination conducted by ICAI, New Delhi.
- ii. **Certificate Course in English Proficiency:** To enhance the spoken and written skills of students in English, a short term certificate course was designed by Dept. of English and was successfully conducted.
- iii. **Preparatory course for MH-CET examination:** The College designed an in-house extensive preparatory course for the students aspiring for MBA entrance MH-CET.

3. Innovations in curricular design and transaction:

- i. The syllabus of our regular courses like B.COM, M.COM, BCCA, BBA, MBA are designed by R.T.M. Nagpur University. The college on its part implements the syllabus and their revised versions if any from time to time.
- ii. Innovative approach to learning is carried out by conducting the following activities.
