### Objectives:

1. To encourage research based activities amongst students and teachers.
2. To encourage students to explore new areas of research.
3. To organize research methodology workshops for students and teachers.
4. To arrange for research activities by providing infrastructure such as computers, Internet facility and research based magazines and journals.

The research cell conducts several activities annually for the benefit of students and teachers. The student centric activities includes

- Case study presentation competition.
- Research methodology workshops.
- Providing guidance to students for participation in research and commerce oriented competition and events.

The teachers are also encouraged to engage in research oriented activities. Workshops on 'research culture', Research Methodology, writing a good research paper, research in commerce etc. have been conducted by the Research Cell for the benefit of the teachers.

The cell encourages the teachers to do more publications and also to participate and organize seminars, conference and workshops. The faculty members of our college have published a large number of papers out of which some are in referred national journals, while some papers have been published in EBSCO and other international journal with impact factor.

Our teachers contribute on regular basis in research journals with over 70 papers published in the last 5 years.

We have to our credit 2 major research projects, 8 minor research projects, and 3 ongoing minor research projects.

We have completed and presented to Asst commissioner LBT, a self financed research project on Challenges & Issues of LBT faced by traders in Nagpur City.

The faculty members have also authored some books and presented research papers in seminars and conferences.

One of our teachers has also written 2 e-books available with Baker & Taylor who are indexed with Scopus.

The college has taken several steps to promote research culture among the faculty. They include enhancement of infrastructure facilities, improvement in library facilities, provision of NRC (Network Resource Centre), subscription to more research journals, provision of N-List facility etc. The college provides facilities to teachers for their quality up-gradation and the management also provides seed money for research in case there is no research funding from UGC or other bodies. Owing to this encouragement, as many as 22 teachers of all departments, on the college's rolls, have Ph.D. qualifications and 7 of them are also research supervisors.

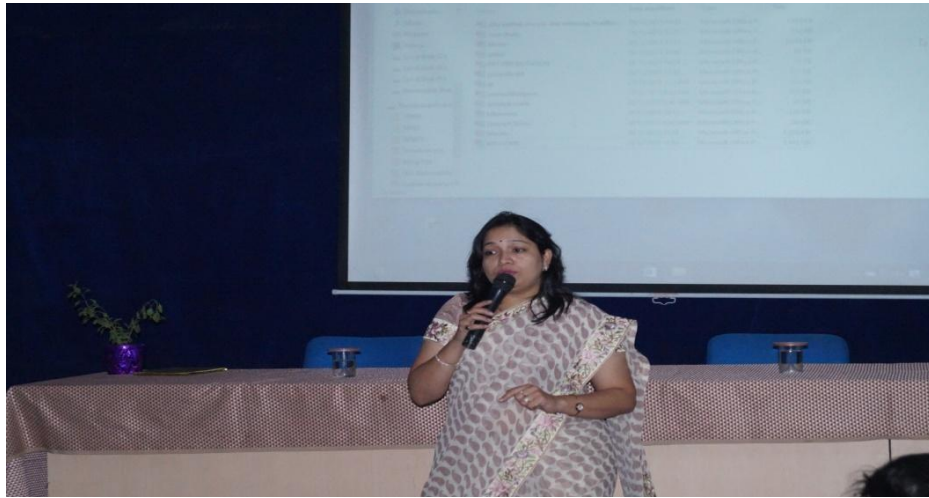
