Annual Report 2020-21

NCC Unit of our college is attached with 4Mah Bn NCC Nagpur. In this year total 108 cadets (51 Boys and 57 Girls) were the part of this unit.

Aims of NCC –

The aims of NCC are mainly three-fold:-

(a) To develop following qualities in the cadets:-

(i) Character (ii) Comradeship (iii) Discipline (iv) Secular Outlook (v) Spirit of Adventure (vi) Ideals of selfless service.

(b) To create a human resource of organised, trained and motivated youth, to provide leadership in all walks of life who will serve the nation regardless of which career they choose.

(c) To provide an environment conducive to motivating young Indians to choose the Armed Forces as a career.

Objectives of NCC-

The objectives of the NCC are:-

(a) Train volunteer youth to become confident, committed and competent leaders in all walks of life.

(b) Enhance awareness levels of cadets to become responsible citizens of the country.

(c) Provide opportunities and encourage cadets to enrich their knowledge, develop communication skills and build character.

(g) Conduct military training to develop awareness about Armed Forces, leadership skills and military values thus, provide an environment to motivate cadets to join the Armed Forces.

For overall development of the cadets, various activities have been conducted in this session as follows-

- 1) On the occasion of International Yog Day (IYD), a webinar was organised in which 35 NCC cadets had participated.
- 2) “Ek Ghar Ek Vruksh”, under this mission many cadets have planted trees in their nearby residence area.
- 3) Under “Atma Nirbhar Bharat Abhiyaan”, cadets have prepared and uploaded their videos, photos in social media platform to propogate home made products.
- 4) Under “Swachh Bharat Abhiyan” NCC cadets participated in various cleanliness drive.
- 5) 23 NCC cadets of our college donated blood in a Blood Donation Camp organised by 4Mah Bn NCC.
- 6) SUO Ayushi Nagpur was selected for 26 Jan 2021 Republic Day parade at Rajpath New Delhi to represent NCC Maharashtra directorate who secured Second Prize.
- 7) 25 NCC Cadets of our college participated in Covid-19 duty with civil administration in the month of April-May 2020.
- 8) 59 NCC Cadets of our college participated in Annual Training Camp organised by 4Mah Bn NCC in our college premises in the month of Feb. 2021.
