The following Initiatives were taken for the implementation of innovative teaching and learning practices in the classroom:

- i) Practice problems are solved for practical subjects like Indirect Taxes in the virtual classes.
- ii) Case laws are discussed and explained in the virtual classes for subjects such as Direct Taxes. Sessions are conducted to explain the e-filing of Tax returns.

ICT-enabled tools including online resources for effective teaching and learning:

1) Google Classroom (Android, iOS): This ICT tool is used to create online courses, dissemination of Notes, conduct online tests, dissemination of home assignments and conduct examinations

2) Liquid Test (iOS): Liquid text is used for online tutoring through virtual lectures. This application enables the tutor to explain the topic more effectively with the use of annotations, linking of external text with the shared notes etc.

3) Kahoot (Android, iOS): This ICT Tool is used to conduct online interactive quizzes to review the understanding of the topic among the students.

4) Margin Note 3 (iOS): This tool is used to explain topics with the help of mind maps. This tool also enables the tutor to review the understanding of students about the case with the help of flash cards.

5) Microsoft Excel (Android, iOS, Windows): MS Excel is used for solving numerical problems in the subjects such as Financial Management, Direct Taxes etc. in virtual lectures so that students should understand the proforma and presentation of solving the issues of the examination.

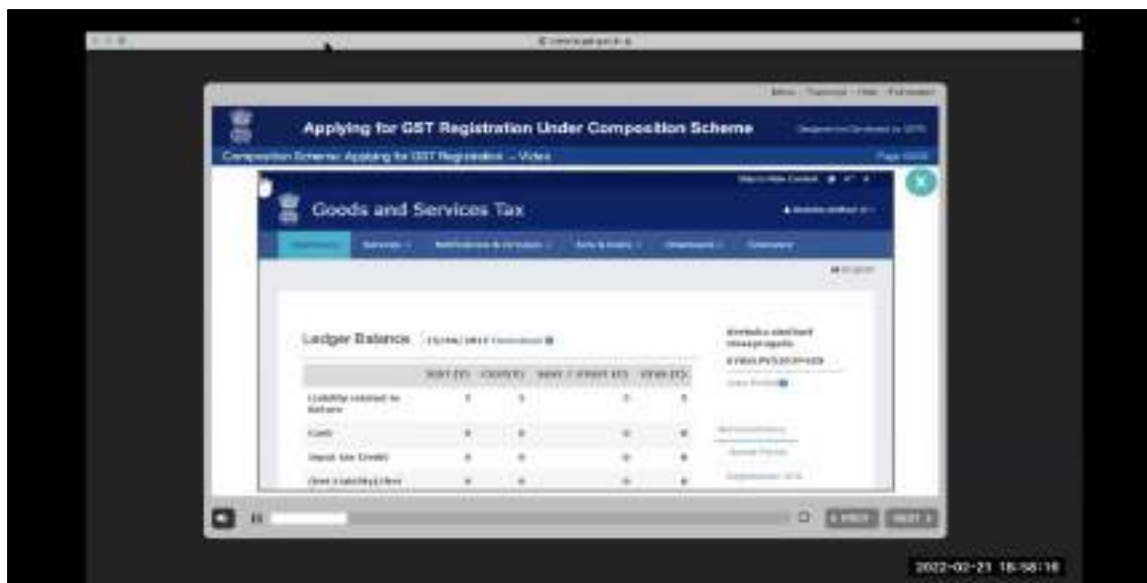
6) MS PowerPoint (Android, iOS, Windows): MS PowerPoint is used to explain various topics with the help of presentations.

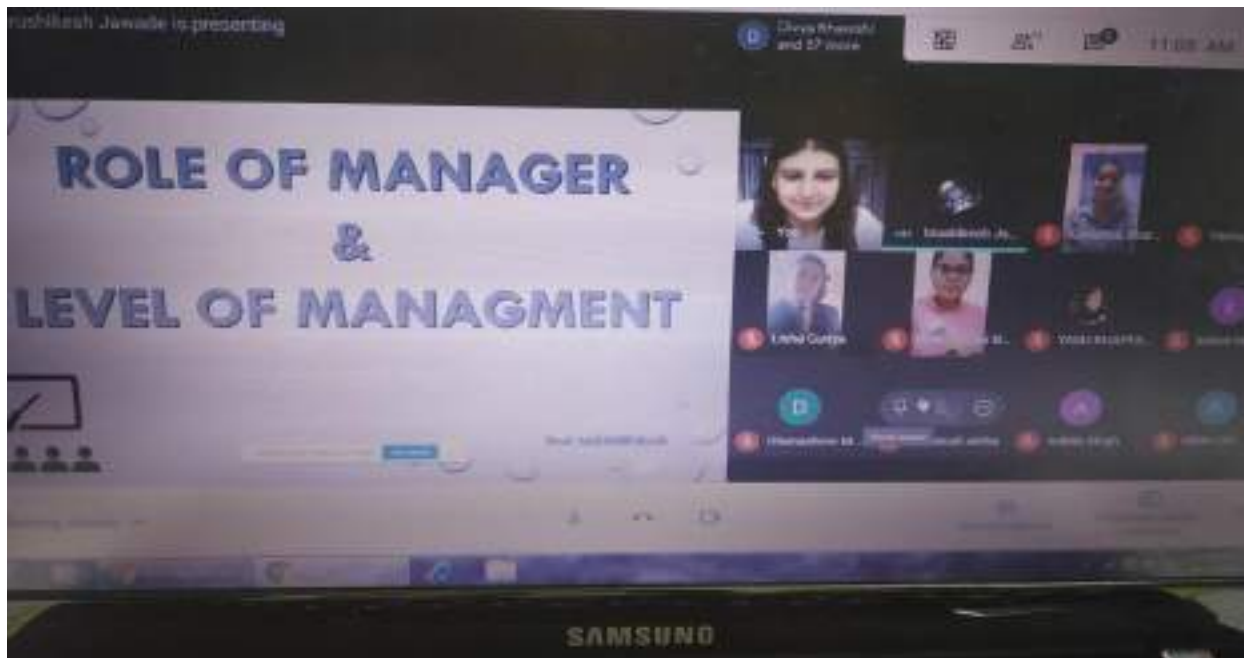

1. The discussion revolved around the women Entrepreneurs in the industry, the business they have ventured into, and the strategies they are using to expand their business. This was followed by a discussion on the business ideas which the students can develop and succeed at. The idea behind this activity was to develop a sense of entrepreneurship, creative idea development & business in the students. The motive also was to encourage healthy discussions in the class, to improve the confidence & the communication skills of the students. The beneficiaries for the activity were 145 students from the said classes.
2. Discussions on Planning, executing a business idea in minimum investment The following activity was taken for the students of B.Com (Honours) & B.Com (Finance & Accountancy) under the Principles of Business Management subject. The students were encouraged to think of creative ideas for business with a minimum investment of Rs. 10,000 /- & then show the working and sustainability of the same for one year. The idea behind this activity was to develop a sense of entrepreneurship, creative idea development & business in the students. The motive was also to show that business basically doesn't require a huge investment to start, this gave the students an idea of exploring options where they can become self-dependent. The number of beneficiaries were 167 students from the said classes.

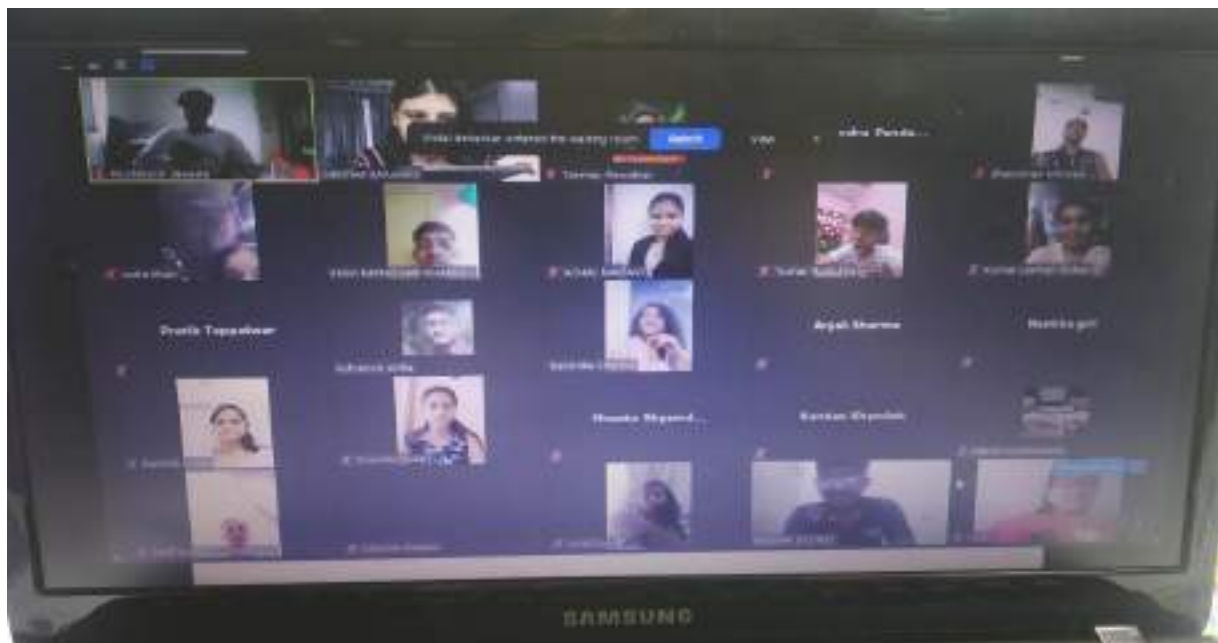
3. Presentations on startup ideas - The following activity was taken for the students of B.Com (Honours) & B.Com (Finance & Accountancy) under the Principles of Business Management subject. The students were encouraged to come up with ideas for start-up and show how they'll be earning a profit in the business through presentations. All the factors both internal and external which are key to the success of the business were discussed. The idea behind this activity was to encourage the students to explore their analytical mind and come up with ideas that can sustain and earn in the upcoming years. The number of beneficiaries were 105 students from the said classes.
4. Quiz on Management topics - The following activity was taken for the students of B.Com (Honours) & B.Com (Finance & Accountancy) under the Principles of Business Management subject. The students were asked management topics in quiz format. The number of beneficiaries were 179 students from the said classes.
5. Presentation and discussion on Formal Etiquettes - The following activity was taken for the students of B.Com (Honours) & B.Com (Finance & Accountancy) under the Business ethics & corporate culture subject. The purpose of this activity was to give a soft skills training to the students on formal etiquette and how to behave in a professional setting. This was a hands-on training session where topics of formal attire, formal communication etc were covered. The purpose behind this activity was to make the students professionally eloquent and industry ready. The number of beneficiaries for the activity were 162 students of the said courses.
6. Practical session on Interview Techniques - The following activity was taken for the students of B.Com (Honours) & B.Com (Finance & Accountancy) under the Business ethics & corporate culture subject. The students were guided regarding how to appear for interviews, both physical and online. The professional attire to follow, how to communicate formally, the way the interview questions have to be answered etc. The purpose behind this activity was to make the students professionally eloquent and industry ready. The number of beneficiaries for the activity were 153 students from the said classes.
7. Practical Session on Resume Writing - The following activity was taken for the students of B.Com (Honours) & B.Com (Finance & Accountancy) under the Business ethics & corporate culture subject. The students were guided regarding how to build resumes. They were shown sample resumes & encouraged to make one for themselves. The purpose behind this activity was to make the students professionally eloquent and industry ready. The number of beneficiaries for the activity were 125 students from the said classes.
8. Case Studies discussion on Scam 1992 - The following activity was taken for the students of B.Com (Honours) & B.Com (Finance & Accountancy) under Indian Financial System subject. The students were encouraged to research and then discuss the said topic. This activity was done to increase their financial knowledge. The number of beneficiaries for the activity were 139 students of the said classes
9. Case studies discussion on Fair and lovely - The following activity was taken for the students of B.Com (Honours) & B.Com (Finance & Accountancy) under the Business

ethics & corporate culture subject. The topic was discussed under the marketing head of the syllabus with a basic objective of making the students understand the marketing tactics of the companies. The students were encouraged to research about the company & their marketing strategies and a discussion on the same was taken in the class. The number of beneficiaries for the activity were 145 students of the said class.

10. Financing a Business Project - The following activity was taken for the students of B.Com (Honours) & B.Com (Finance & Accountancy) under the Management Accounting subject. The students were encouraged to explore the different financing options available for a business. This activity helped the students to practically understand the different avenues available with the business for financing. The beneficiaries for the activity were 160 students of the said classes.
11. Discussion on practical rulings in cases of different companies - The following activity was taken for the students of B.Com (Honours) & B.Com (Finance & Accountancy) under the Company law and secretarial practices subject. The case rulings of different practical companies were discussed in the class to make the students understand the practical implications of the law. The number of beneficiaries for the same were 89 students from the said courses.

Fighting Starvation and Frustration

The pandemic and the lockdowns foiled Saqibul's efforts to rebuild her family's crumbling economic condition. The twenty-seven-year-old mother of four had been struggling to pay off the huge loan that she had taken from a moneylender to undergo a surgery. The meagre income of her husband, who worked as a loader at a scrap dealership, was too little for the family, hence Saqibul started working as a maidservant at multiple houses in Mumbai. The couple, hailing from Barabanki district in Uttar Pradesh, had moved to Mumbai in the hope of earning a decent income for raising their four children away from poverty.

Saqibul and her husband lost their jobs immediately after the lockdown was announced. With their purse fast becoming empty and no sight of the lifting of the lockdown, Saqibul and her husband decided to return to their native village in Uttar Pradesh. They took loans from friends to pay Rs. 5000 for the 1400 km-long journey in a truck which was crowded with more than 40 migrants and their families. The journey was a horrific experience for the family because of the extreme heat, hunger and lack of sleep. They had no proper food throughout the four days' journey and all that the parents could get for their children was some biscuits during the journey.

More misery awaited the family at native village. Villagers did not allow the exhausted migrant family to enter the village for the fear of infection and alerted the police. Police quarantined Saqibul and her family for fourteen days in the local school



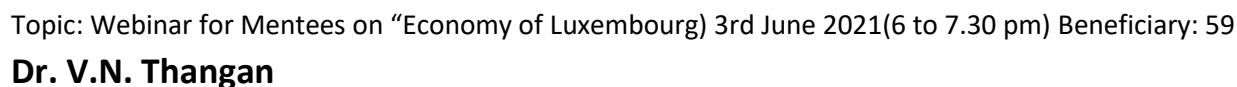
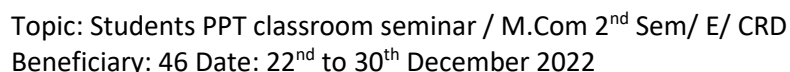
Saqibul with her family at her home in native village which was badly equipped. The family had to again go hungry and sleepless for fourteen days.

Hardships followed the family when they reached to their village home. They had no food and money. Since Saqibul's family did not have a ration card, which meant that they could not get any food grain from the Public Distribution System. Now the family survives on a share of food supply that Saqibul's in-laws get from the PDS. With no work in sight, the liabilities of Saqibul's family are mounting. Moneylender has started harassing because she has defaulted the loan repayment. She is undeterred by the harrowing experience of return journey and determined to return to Mumbai. Saqibul and her husband Shabbaz are eagerly awaiting the end of lockdown for taking the first train to Mumbai to work. They have no other choice; they have four children to raise and a big loan to repay.
