



## **PROGRAMMING LANGUAGE USED IN PROJECT:-**

- **PHP: Personal HomePage:**

- PHP is popular general-purpose scripting language that is especially suited to web development. It was originally created by Ramus Lerdorf in 1994, the PHP reference implementation is now produced by the PHP Group. PHP originally stood for Personal Home Page, but it now stands for the recursive initialize PHP: Hypertext Pre-processor.
- PHP code may be executed with a command line interface (CLI), embedded into HTML code, Or used in combination with various web template system, web content management systems and web frameworks. PHP code is usually processed by a PHP interpreter implemented as a module in a web server or as a Common Gateway Interface (CGI) executable. The web server outputs the results of the interpreted and executed PHP code, which may be any type of data, such as generated HTML code or binary image data. PHP can be used for many programming tasks outside of the web context, such as standalone graphical applications and robotic drone control.

- **HTML: Hypertext Markup Language**

- Hypertext Markup Language (HTML) is a standard markup language for documents designed to be displayed in a web browser. It can be assisted by

technologies such as Cascading Style Sheets (CSS) and scripting languages such as JavaScript.

- Web browser receive HTML documents from a web server or from local storage and render the documents into multimedia web pages. HTML describes the structure of a web page semantically and originally included cues for the appearance of the document
  - HTML elements are the building blocks of HTML pages. With HTML constructs, images and other objects such as interactive forms may be embedded into the rendered page. HTML provides a means to create structured documents by denoting structural semantics for text such as headings, paragraphs, lists, links, quotes and other items. HTML elements are delineated by tags, written using angle brackets. Tags such as `<img/>` and `<input/>` directly introduce content into the page. Other tags such as `<p>` surround and provide information about document text and may include other tags as sub-elements. Browsers do not display the HTML tags, but use them to interpret the content of the page.
  - HTML can embed programs written in a scripting language such as JavaScript, which affects the behavior and content of webpages
- 
- **CSS :- Cascading Style Sheets**
    - Cascading Style Sheets (CSS) is a style sheet language used for describing the presentation of a document written in a markup language like HTML. CSS is a cornerstone technology of the World Wide Web, alongside HTML and JavaScript.
    - CSS is designed to enable the separation of presentation and content, including layout, colours, and fonts. This separation can improve content

accessibility, provide more flexibility and control in the specification of presentation characteristics.

- Enable multi web pages to share formatting by specifying the relevant CSS in a separate. Css file, and reduce complexity and repetition in the structural content.
- Separation of formatting and content also makes it feasible to present the same markup page in different styles for different rendering methods, such as on-screen , in print, by voice(via speech based browser on screen reader ), and on Braille based tactile devices. CSS also has rules for alternate formatting if the content is accessed on a mobile device. The name cascading comes from the specified priority scheme to determine which style rule applies if more than one rule matches a particular element. This cascading priority scheme is predictable. A CSS framework is a library allowing for easier, more standards-compliant web design using the Cascading-Style-Sheets language. Most of these frameworks contain at least a grid.

- **BASIC STRUCTURE OF THE WEBSITE:-**

-:Tags:-

- **HTML TAG:**

The very first thing is the doctype declaration of the document.In this case HTML5.You should always use this. The entire document is placed between the <HTML>.....</HTML>

- **HEAD TAG:**

Marks the start of the part of a HTML document called the head. This section is not visible on the webpage but it carries important information about the document.

- **TITLE TAG:**

The page title can be seen in the browser window tab and when you bookmark the site in your favourites. You can put everything you want to in between the title tags. We also see something new here too. The last tag `</title>`, means that the tag title now ends. You can end any tag by putting a backslash (/) after the less-than sign.

- **BODY TAG:**

The `<body>` element forms the main body of the HTML document. We can use `<BODY>` tag to specify background color and margin of text in HTML tag.

- **SCRIPT TAG:**

The `<style>` tag is used to define style information for an HTML document. Inside the `<style>` element you specify how HTML elements should render in a browser. Each HTML document can contain multiple `<style>` tags.

- **LINE BREAK:**

Line Breaks are different than most of the tags we have seen so far. A line break ends the line you are currently on and resumes on the next line. Placing `<br/>` within the code is same as pressing return key in a word processor. Use the `<br />` tag within the `<p>` (paragraph) tag.

- **HEADING TAG:**

HTML defines six levels of heading. A heading element implies. A heading element implies all the font changes, paragraph breaks before and after, and any white space necessary to render the heading. The heading elements are H1, H2, H3, H4, H5 and H6 with H1 being the highest (or most important) level and H6 the least.

- **FORM TAG:**

The `<form>` tag in HTML is used to create form for user input. There are many elements which are used within form tag. The HTML `<form>` tag is used for creating a form for user input. A form can contain textfield's, checkboxes, radio-buttons and more. Forms are used to pass user-data to specified URL.

- **TABLE TAG:**

The HTML table allows web authors to arrange data like text, images, links, other tables, etc. into rows and columns of cells. The HTML tables are created using the `<table>` tag in which the `<tr>` tag is used to create table rows and `<td>` tag is used to create data cells. The elements under `<td>` are regular and left aligned by default.






#Data Flow Diagram





- **TESTING**

Testing is vital to success off system. System testing makes a logical assumption that if all the parts of system are correct, the goal will be successfully achieved. Inadequate testing or non-testing leads to error that may not appear.

This create two problems:-

- The time lag between the cause and the appearance of the problem (the longer the time interval, the more complicated the problems has became)

**:- TYPES OF TESTINT :-**

- **Alpha Testing:-**

Alpha Testing is carried out at the end of the software development phase but, before the Beta Testing. Still, minor design changes may be made as a result of such testing. - **Beta Testing:-**

Beta Testing is a formal type of Software Testing which is carried out by the customer. It is performed in the Real Environment before releasing the product to the market for the actual end-user. Beta Testing is successful when the customer accepts the software.

- **Back-end testing:-**

Whenever an input or data is entered on front-end application, it stores in database and the testing of such database is known as Database Testing or Backend Testing. Testers are directly connected to the database with proper access and testers can easily verify data by running a few queries on the database.
