#### Examination Committee Report 2021-2022

The college has been granted with autonomy status since 2018 and the college established a separate autonomy examination cell to conduct the examinations smoothly. The Principal of the college is the Chief Controller of Examinations. The Controller of Examinations, appointed by the Principal from among teachers in the college, manages various examination operations with the help of the Examination Committee and other office support.

The 2021–2022 session was partially affected by the COVID-19 wave. We conducted the Winter-2021 examinations in online mode and Summer-2022 examinations in offline mode. We conducted full-fledged three-hour descriptive online semester end examinations and supplementary examinations for the backlog students in Winter-2021. Students were also evaluated for their participation and performance in co- and extra-curricular activities, as well as for their performance in value-addition courses, in addition to their academic performance. We conducted semester-end examinations of all UG and PG courses by issuing a special Direction No. 03/2021.

After the COVID-19 wave, we conducted all the Summer-2022 examinations in regular offline mode by issuing a special Direction No. 01/2022.

To conduct online examinations, we created various WhatsApp groups for students and also purchased 2 TB of space from Google to store the answer files submitted by students. We provided the question paper pdf to them through whatsapp groups 10 minutes prior to the commencement of the examination, and they submitted their answer sheets to us on the given Google form within 15 minutes after the expiry of time. After receiving and downloading the answer papers, we printed and bundled them and got them valued by both the internal and external valuers at the college's spot valuation centre as per our regular practice of evaluation.

The college has constituted a separate Grievance Redressal Committee for grievances related to autonomy examinations and evaluation and other related issues. The COE is the chairman of the committee, HOD's of all the departments are its members. In the event of any grievance, the matter is referred to Principal/Chief Controller whose decision is final.

During the Winter-2021 examinations, we received a few grievances telephonically regarding technical issues in online examination which were sorted out. We conducted online sessions through Zoom or Google platforms to answer the queries of students. For technical support, we

have given two contact numbers for addressing and helping students during online submission of answer sheets. Due care was taken to resolve all the issues.

During the period, we conducted all UG and PG examinations through online mode and offline mode and declared results as soon as possible. The details are as follows:
