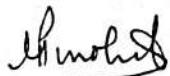

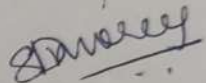

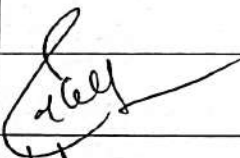

- 1) **Confirmation of the minutes of the last meeting held on 23<sup>rd</sup> May 2018:** All the members of the Board have confirmed the minutes of the last meeting held as on 23<sup>rd</sup> May 2018.
- 2) **To brief the subjects falls under the Board of Studies in Commerce:** All the members of the Board have received syllabus of all Courses under Autonomous Curriculum. All faculties were requested to submit a review on the syllabi of subjects taught by them, along with the modifications or changes, if any. But no modifications or changes in the syllabi of the subjects has been received by them. Therefore, Board has finalized the syllabi of all subjects under Board of Studies in Commerce as it is. Further, it has been decided that in future during teaching a syllabus of subjects under Autonomous Curriculum of upcoming Semesters, if teaching faculties feel any changes or modifications as necessary to be done in the syllabi from the student's point of view, they may share the same with the Board of Studies.
- 3) **To discuss the proposed subjects under Board of Studies in Commerce for new Courses to be introduced i.e. B.Com. (Honors) and B.Com. (Finance and Accounts):** The subjects under the proposed new courses under Autonomous Curriculum to be implemented from the upcoming academic year i.e. B.Com. (Honors) and B.Com. (Finance and Accounts) have been reviewed by all members of the Board. Members said that the subjects are quite impressive.
- 4) **To discuss and finalize the names of Paper-Setters/Examiners/Moderators etc. for autonomous exam pattern:** Members of Board have suggested some names of the faculties to be called for papers setting/moderating purpose. They have promised to send a list of suggested faculties through an email.



### **Suggestions from the Members of the Board:**

1) Members of the Board (Dr. S. R. Jichkar) expressed his opinion that the syllabus of the subjects under Autonomous Curriculum is very vast from the student's point of view. Students as well as teaching faculties may feel burdensome and pressurized while dealing with such a vast syllabus. He has advised to rethink about the subjects especially such as Computer Application in Business containing topics like e-filing of Income Tax Returns etc.

2) Dr. S. R. Jichkar further suggested to adapt flip classroom methodology, according to which students should be encouraged for self-study gradually. According to him, proportion of teaching and self-study by students can be developed in the following manner (as a sort of example):

In 1<sup>st</sup> Year – 40% Self Study and 60% Teaching

In 2<sup>nd</sup> Year – 50 Self Study and 50% Teaching

In 3<sup>rd</sup> Year – 60% Self Study and 40% Teaching

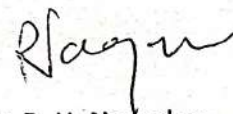
Dr. S. R. Jichkar advised to follow UGC Guidelines applicable for Autonomous Institutions as well as RTMNU Guidelines. He further added that there should be 90 days teaching in one semester. Thus, total teaching including both semesters, in an academic year should be 180 days in aggregate.

Board Members have suggested that College should decide an eligibility criterion for admission in new courses such as B.Com. (Honors) and B.Com. (Finance and Accounts) such as Percentage in 12<sup>th</sup>.

Board members has suggested that there are too many optional subjects in new courses under Autonomous curriculum. They have suggested to conduct a survey after 1<sup>st</sup> Batch and list the names of subjects in which students are more interested and those which enhance their employability and then increase the subjects accordingly and gradually.

Board members appreciated various subjects selected for the proposed courses of B.Com.(Honors) and B.Com. (Finance and Accounts)

At the end, Chairman, Board of Studies in Commerce, has concluded meeting by proposing vote of thanks.

At the outset, the chairman welcomed all the members for the meeting and the conduct of the meeting was as follows:

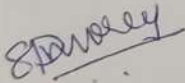
1. Minutes of the meeting held on 23/05/2018 were confirmed.
