The following business took place in the meeting:

- 1. The Academic Council expressed its satisfaction on the progress of Academic Session 2020-2021 so far. The Academic Council appreciated the efforts taken by the teachers for completing the syllabus in 60 hours which is equivalent to 15 weeks/90 days of teaching.
- 2. The Academic Council discussed various aspects for the revision of Academic Calendars of all academic programmes for the sessions 2020-2021 and 2021-2022. The Academic Council approved the revision of all Academic Calendars for all the programmes and the rescheduling of examinations so as to have early examinations and timely declaration of results. The members noted with satisfaction that due to the revision of Academic Calendars and rescheduling of examinations, students are

not losing anything and that all the sessions from 2022-2023 onwards would be as per the original schedules.

3. Accordingly, the Academic Council unanimously passed the resolution that:

"In order to put the Academic Sessions back on track after the disruption owing to the Covid-19 pandemic, it is necessary to revise the Academic Calendars of various UG and PG programmes so that the next academic session will start from 15th June 2022 and students will not lose any time or suffer any academic loss, the Academic Council unanimously approves the revision of Academic Calendars and rescheduling of examinations."

- 4. The Academic Council approved under AOB the panel of experts from the other universities to be nominated on various Boards of Studies. It is necessitated because of the expiry of the member's term of 3 years.
- 5. The Academic Council also suggested that the teachers may be given compensatory leave those are working against the summer and winter vacation, if possible as permissible by rules.
- 6. Dr. K. C. Deshmukh suggested that for maintaining the National and International standard of education Board of Studies and Academic Council should upgrade and update the syllabus every year.
- 7. Principal Dr. N. Y. Khandait expressed his gratitude for all nominated members for their support to the college's academic plans under autonomy during their term which is about the expire.
- 8. All the nominated members wished well for the college's progress under autonomy and promised that they would continue to support the college's academic endeavors in future too.

Prof. Akash S. Jain, Secretary, Academic Council, welcomed all the new members of Academic Council. He briefed about the agenda of the meeting i.e. to discuss and approve the revised direction regarding conduct of Winter 2021 examination in the wake of COVID-19 pandemic situation. He invited Dr. N. Y. Khandait Chairman, Academic Council and Principal, G. S. College of Commerce & Economics, Nagpur, to brief the Council about the proposed direction.

Dr. N. Y. Khandait, Chairman, Academic Council welcomed Prof. Akash S. Jain as the new Secretary, Academic Council, and also welcomed all the new members in Academic Council as under:

Dr. N. Y. Khandait then explained the college's point of view regarding the conduct of Winter 2021 examination in the wake of the Covid-19 situation. He shared the statistics of vaccinated students and added that since all educational institutions have reopened and fully vaccinated students are allowed to attend the classes, the college is of opinion of conducting Winter/2021 examination in both offline mode (for fully vaccinated students) and online mode (for partially and non-vaccinated students).

However, all the experts present in the meeting were of the view that it would not be advisable to conduct examination of the same batch of students in two different modes which may create some technical problems. Further, students may also face difficulties in transport, hostel and lodging boarding facilities etc. while reporting to the college for offline examination. The brief summary of the views expressed by the experts is as under:

- Shri. Gulabrao Thakare: The college should conduct examination in either fully offline mode or fully online mode instead of adopting the hybrid mode. In view of the pandemic situation, the preferred mode of examination should be online only.
- Shri. Hemant Singhal suggested that the examination should be in online mode only.
- Shri. CA Julfesh Shah: Owing to the Government Guidelines, the examination should be conducted in online mode even though the college may have sufficient infrastructure for the conduct offline examination.
- Dr. Sujit Metre: Since students below 18 and with single-dose who form a big chunk of students will be prevented from taking offline examination, it would be better that examination should be conducted in online mode.
- Dr. Pandurang Dange: Examination should be conducted in online mode in view of the difficulties in conducting the examination in offline mode especially for outstation students.

Accordingly, it was decided that a revised direction prescribing only online mode for the conduct of Winter 2021 examination should be drafted and shared with the academic council on 29.11.2021. The meeting was therefore adjourned.

Subsequently, the revised draft of direction was circulated among all the members of the academic council on 29.11.2021 in the morning and the adjourned meeting was reconvened on 29.11.2021 at 04:00 p.m.

All the members of the academic council unanimously approved the revised direction regarding "THE CONDUCT OF EXAMINATION OF WINTER 2021 FOR REGULAR STUDENTS OF ALL ODD SEMESTERS OF ALL UG AND PG PROGRAMMES AND EX-STUDENTS WITH BACKLOG OF FAILED SUBJECTS OF ALL PREVIOUS SEMESTERS OF ALL UG AND PG PROGRAMMES IN THE WAKE OF COVID-19".

- 3. Prof. Akash Jain read out the agenda and informed that all the draft Direction was already sent to all members on their respective email ids. He requested Principal Dr N. Y. Khandait to elaborate on the Direction.
- 4. Dr N. Y. Khandait explained to the members the background and the necessity of the Direction regarding the conduct of Summer 2022 examination in the offline mode and also the need of relaxing the minimum attendance criteria for appearing in the examinations due to the Covid-19 situation. He explained that the Covid-19 restrictions are no longer in place and that all the students were fully vaccinated and that the physical classes are already underway and also that the prelims too have been conducted offline and therefore the S/2022 examinations can be conducted offline. He also informed that owing to the lingering Covid-19, transport problems, health issues etc., several students could not attend the classes physically and therefore they should be allowed to appear in the S/2022 examinations without insisting upon the minimum attendance criteria.
- 5. All the members present in the meeting in offline modes including Dr Pandurang Dange and Dr Sujit Metre, accepted the proposal and the related Direction. Dr Ranjana Sahu and Prof. Preeti Rangari, who joined online, also concurred with the proposal of offline examination.
- 6. Shri Gulabrao Thakre, Shri Hemant Singhal, Shri Julfesh Shah and Dr Milind Gulhane also concurred with the proposal and Direction.
