(REGARDING INTERNAL ASSESSMENT MECHANISM FOR ALL UG NON-NEP PROGRAMMES OF B.COM., B.C.C.A., B.B.A., B.COM. (HONORS), B.COM. (F&A) AND PG PROGRAMMES OF M.COM. AND M.B.A.)

G. S. College of Commerce and Economics, Nagpur has been granted autonomy by the University Grants Commission (UGC) and the RTM Nagpur University, Nagpur from the session 2018-2019. As an autonomous college, the college has the mandate to decide its scheme of external and internal examination. Accordingly, the college has conducted till date the external and internal examinations as per the college's Academic Regulations issued from the session 2018-2019 and Revised Academic Regulations issued from the session 2020-2021.
