The following business took place with respect to each item on the agenda:

Dr. Ranjana Sahu, IQAC Coordinator welcomed Shri Sanjay Bhargava, Hon'ble Chairman Shiksha Mandal Wardha, Principal Dr. N. Y. Khandait, External peer team members and all the internal IQAC members present in the meeting. She briefly apprised about the minutes of the IQAC meeting held on 26/03/2022. Approval of the minutes for this meeting has already been taken through e-mail.

Dr. Sahu invited Principal Dr. N. Y. Khandait, Chairman IQAC for his opening remarks. Principal Dr. Khandait welcomed Chairman Shri Sanjay Bhargava Sir and all the external peer team members of IQAC along-with the internal members of IQAC. He shared with all the members about achievements of the college and also invited all the members present in the meeting for the First Commencement Ceremony and upcoming NAAC sponsored seminar on the topic "NEP: Challenges and Opportunities for HEIs" scheduled on 29th and 30th July, 2022 respectively. He thanked and also bid his adieu to all the external members as he is going to retire on 31st of this month and formally welcomed his successor Dr. S. S. Kathaley to take the baton to further the college's development.

Dr. S. S. Kathaley thanked Chairman Sir for giving this huge responsibility and promised to come up to the expectations of the management.

Hon'ble Chairman Sir and IQAC members appreciated the efforts of Principal Dr. N. Y. Khandait and wished him good health.

Dr. Sahu, IQAC Co-ordinator thanked Principal Dr. Khandait for his opening remarks and for his sincere efforts to enhance the college's quality profile and furthering the development of college.

Dr. Sahu then took the agenda proper and shared the college's progress so far with the IQAC members:

A. CURRICULAR ASPECTS:

 The College's two new UG programmes of B.Com. (Honours) and B.Com. (Finance & Accountancy) which were started from the session 2020-21 have received good

- admissions in 2021-22 as well receiving admissions from across the various parts of country.
- In all, the College is successfully conducting 5 UG and 2 PG programmes under Autonomy.
- The first 2 batches of PG programmes of MBA and M.Com. (2019-20 and 2020-21)
 under Autonomy have already rolled out while the 2021-22 batches are yet to go their
 final Semester-end examinations owing to the delayed start of sessions due to Covid19.
- The first autonomous batches of the UG programmes of B. Com., B.Com. (Computer Application) and BBA have rolled out in 2020-21 while the 2021-22 batches have already appeared for examinations.
- Further, the Commencement/Degree Distribution Ceremony of all the UG/PG programmes upto S/2021 examinations is being scheduled on 29th July 2022.
- 6. The College has also published the merit lists of all its programmes upto S/2021.
- The College has also added 2 new value-addition certificate courses of GST and Business Analytics.
- The College is contemplating some UG/PG programmes under the New Education Policy.

A. TEACHING, LEARNING AND EVALUATION:

- All the teaching-learning activity was conducted online for all the programmes upto January 2022 and the physical classes started from February 2022.
- 2. The College conducted its T/L activity schedules as per its own Academic Calendars.
- 3. In order to ensure the completion of entire coursework in the curtailed session of 60-65 days (instead of the usual 90 days/15 weeks and 75 lectures of 48 minutes @ 5 lectures per week) and further to ensure that there was no academic loss, and also to ensure that students did not face any hardship due to online teaching, which is a new experience for them, all teachers conducted minimum 60 lectures of full one hour duration for minimum 60 days @ 6 lectures per week (which is equivalent of 75 lectures of 48 minutes @ 5 lectures per week for 15 weeks/90 days. This is a commendable move by the College. The teachers are also worthy of appreciation for their commitment to the cause of education for which they forfeited their Summer 2022 vacations.
- 4. Students were also assigned Summer Internship Projects.
- 5. The College conducted its stipulated internal and external examinations in both online (upto January 2022) and offline (from February 2022) modes. All these examinations were conducted as per the full-length descriptive pattern dispensing with the MCQ/Objective pattern of examinations as adopted by the parent University.
- The College also conducted physical spot evaluation for which they received good support from the external examiners.

HIGHLIGHTS:

 The College has boldly departed from the general trend of conducting online examinations with MCQ pattern and conducted its S/2022 examinations for all programmes in physical mode with full-length descriptive questions pattern as stipulated in the Academic Regulations. The students have whole-heartedly welcomed this move of the college as is evident by the attendance percentage in examinations.

B. RESEARCH & EXTENSION:

- The College is recognized as a "Place of Higher Learning and Research" by the parent RTM Nagpur University.
- In 2021-22, the college added 02 more Ph.D. supervisors to its panel taking its tally to 07 Supervisors. It also added 4 more students. Thus at present there are 09 students who are pursuing Ph.D. at the college's Research Centre.
- 3. The College provides for the anti-plagiarism software.
- The College has set up an Anti-plagiarism Research Ethics Committee.
- Dr Ranjana Sahu, who is also the IQAC Coordinator, has already submitted her research project to the ICSSR.

MINUTES OF THE IQAC MEETING HELD ON 18/10/2022

The IQAC meeting was conducted on 18th October 2022 at 01.00 PM in the Bajaj Bhawan. All the Criterion Incharges, IQAC coordinator and all teachers were present in the meeting which was presided by Hon'ble Chairman Shri Sanjay Bhargava. IQAC coordinator Dr. Ranjana Sahu welcomed Hon'ble Chairman Shri Sanjay Bhargava, Respected Kale Sir-Dean Commerce, Respected Principal Madam and all the colleagues for this review meeting.

She shared with the gathering that with all the support and cooperation, we have recently submitted our AQAR 2020-21 on 29 August 2022. She thanked the Criterion Incharges as without them this work could not have been possible. She extended her heartfelt thanks to each and every one present there in the meeting. As per NAAC mandate we have to submit IIQA

- 1. Eligible HEIs seeking A&A are required to submit Institutional Information for Quality Assessment (IIQA) online any time during the year. Duly filled in IIQAs of eligible HEIs will be accepted by NAAC for further processing and others will be rejected.
- 2. In case of rejection of IIQA applications specific suggestions would be given to HEIs to facilitate them to resubmit IIQA. An institution can reapply twice after the first attempt resulted in rejection. That is, each HEI is permitted three attempts in a year, with a single fee. After this, it will be considered a fresh application with required fees.

After the acceptance of IIQA, the institution will be asked to fill the Self Study Report (SSR) with the required document to be uploaded in the portal of NAAC website within 45 days. The SSR of the HEI will then be subjected to further process. As preparation of SSR is a systematic process, so it is suggested that the HEIs should be ready with soft copy of SSR and related documents well in advance of submitting IIQA. Those institutions who fail to submit SSR within 45 days will have to apply afresh starting from IIQA & its fees. (25,000 + GST18%) non refundable and A&A fees 1 lakh +GST.

She then invited hon'ble Chairman sir for his opening remarks. He emphasized that Autonomous 'A' Grade is non-negotiable and all must contribute in this regard. He asked all criterion incharges for giving brief presentation for their respective criterion.

All the Criterion Incharges were informed by IQAC Co-ordinator that we have successfully submitted AQAR 2020-21 on 29th August 2022 and after suggested revisions resubmitted it on 2nd Sept 2022 with your support and cooperation. We are in the process of submission of AQAR 2021-22 for which last date is December 31, 2022. The draft webpage for AQAR requirements has been sent through mail for your reference to collect the data accordingly on 3rd September 2022. She then apprised them about the current status for preparation of AQAR 2021-22. She insisted upon that no field is left blank. (00/NIL). If anything remained pending last time (AQAR 2020-21) and has been written as under process the same should be completed. Attainment of Outcomes under Criterion II is still under process and should be submitted by all Programme Co-ordinators for 2 Batches under Autonomy.



After the acceptance of IIQA, the institution will be asked to fill the Self Study Report (SSR) with the required document to be uploaded in the portal of NAAC website within 45 days. The SSR of the HEI will then be subjected to further process. As preparation of SSR is a systematic process, so it is suggested that the HEIs should be ready with soft copy of SSR and related documents well in advance of submitting IIQA. Those institutions who fail to submit SSR within 45 days will have to apply afresh starting from IIQA & its fees. (25,000 + GST18%) non-refundable and A&A fees 1 lakh +GST.

This year in the month of June 2023, we plan to submit our SSR. We have already provided all the concerned teachers templates through mail dated 6/11/2018, 22/6/2020 and given reminders in all IQAC

meetings for SSR preparations and SSR data collection for all 5 years with supportive documents. Dr. Sahu further added as only few months remained; we all have to start working on it. We have to start working on write-ups, numeric boxes, xl sheets/templates, geo-tag photos, pdfs, website uploads, additional information, reports, etc. to meet this proposed date of submission of SSR. All criterion incharges should

inform all the teachers concerned and metrics incharges (if any) to submit only geo-tagged photos. She has already distributed hard copies of templates and QIF format to all seven Criterion In-charges. Soft copy will also be sent for their reference. Focus Area for NAAC 2023 was also given to them as per

instructions of Principal Madam. She informed all that Criterion Incharges have also sent data requirement templates to all concerns for their respective criterion.

She explained about evaluative report which is to be submitted by each department for SSR.

She once again told that as per NAAC manual for metric related to financial matters the preceding FY (April to March 31) may be used to consolidate data, for publications related data- Calendar Year may be taken and for all other purpose Academic Year may be taken into consideration. of

alumni members peer and external of the members invited IQAC for their valuable inputs. Dr. Dipti Christian emphasized on the link between outcome realized and students' progression and placement. She opined that mapping of measurable outcomes are very important. Dr. K T Thomas suggested that IIQA should be sent only when SSR is ready as within 30 days of submission of IIQA, SSR should be submitted. He suggested for proper documentation and less DVV clarifications. CA Yash Varma suggested for interactive session with Alumni and he extended helping hand for Alumni Meet/Association. Dr. Sahu thanked all the members for sharing valuable inputs.

Dr. Ranjana Sahu invited Hon'ble Chairman Shiksha Mandal Wardha, Shri Sanjay Bhargava to share his valuable inputs. He gave approval for uploading of AQAR 2021-22. He also instructed criterion incharges to submit all data for SSR by the end of March 31 and any updates may be given as and when done to ensure timely submission of SSR (in any case before JUNE 30, 2023). He also instructed IQAC Co-ordinator to take a review meeting every fortnight and provide an update to the management regarding these preparations. He added that NAAC 'A' Grade is non-negotiable and all pending work of proper documentation, IIQA etc to be completed in time so that by JUNE 2023 we are in a position to submit SSR and any delay should not happen from our part as it will result in Non-Accreditation Period after December 2023. He also enquired about assessment on the basis of benchmarks as discussed in the last meeting and to go for NAAC Mock Test as soon as we have all 5 years data from all criterion incharges.




