Section 1 – About the programme

`Trash to treasure' is a flagship programme offered by Greenvio Solutions as part of CER (Corporate Environment Responsibility).

The motto is **'One man's trash is another man's treasure'** and it is an eco-socioeconomical initiative for upcycling waste into a useful product for the community.

Note: The programme is being conducted as a multi-disciplinary firm of Architecture, Environment and not at par with any governmental permission etc. The process involves:

- **Step 1** Waste collected from Donor Institute
- Step 2- Recycled to an Upcycled product
- Step 3- Handed over to Beneficiary Organization/ NGO/ SHG
- Step 4 The waste can be converted into an installation or architectural intervention

The Organization providing waste is known as **'Donor Institute'** entitled to receive:

- **Cash reward** (INR 100 for 5 kg/ 200 for 10 kg / 300 for beyond 10 kg)
- **Certificate** with information of waste contributed to environment and social cause
- **Letter of Appreciation** from Beneficiary Institution for extending their support
- **Sapling planted** in a rural area with photographic evidence shared about it

Whereas, Organization receiving Upcycled product is known as 'Beneficiary Institute'

Section 2 - About the parties involved

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) establishes a partnership between:

Party 1 - Greenvio Solutions is registered as an Environmental and Architectural Design Consultancy firm based in Maharashtra.

Section 3 – Task for the execution

Types of waste involved in the project:

- S E-waste: Desktop, Laptop, Printer, UPS, stabilizers, keyboards, mouse etc.
- S Wooden Furniture waste: Benches, doors, cupboards, cabinets etc.
- Plastic waste: Bottles, chairs, pens, folders, bags etc.
- Iron waste: Grill, gates, jali on windows etc.

The parties agree to the following tasks for this MOU:

Party 1 - Greenvio Solutions

- Waste collection at source
- Upcycling/ processing of the collected waste
- Sensitization program as Webinar/ Seminar at Donor and Beneficiary Organization
- Organizing competition at Donor and Beneficiary Organization
- Arranging campaign for awareness at Donor and Beneficiary Organization

Party 2 - G. S. College of Commerce & Economics, Nagpur (Autonomous)

- Collect waste and inform Party 1 every 3 months/ 6 months or annually.
- Coordinate to arrange webinar/ seminar
- Handover waste in proper condition

Section 4 - Financial Aspects

There is no financial commitment on the part of both the parties. Each financial deal will be mutually offered and agreed upon individually.

Section 5 – Duration of the MoU

The term of this MOU is for a period of 2 years from the effective date of this agreement and may be extended upon written mutual agreement.

Either organization may terminate this MOU upon thirty (30) days written notice without penalties or liabilities.

Note: Since this is a digital MoU established as a type of partnership signatures are excluded as part of the contract. The appointed coordinators shall work accordingly.
