1. Details of the Activities Conducted:

The main aim of setting up a commerce lab is to facilitate students an environment for making experiments of theories and economics laws. To create such environment, the lab has conducted following activities during the academic session 2018-2019:

- 1) **Recognition by Google Inc.:** Commerce lab has conducted a virtual photoshoot of the college premises in the year of 2016 on the onset of NAAC Peer Team Visit. For preparing a virtual tour of the college premises, an official page of commerce Lab was created on Google. These 360-degree photos of the college were uploaded on Google Maps on official page of Commerce Lab. In this year, these efforts were appreciated by Google Inc. through a formal email on occasion of getting more than 500000 views of these 360-degree photos worldwide.
- 2) **Live Screening of Union Finance Budget 2019:** To acquaint students with the presentation of budget in parliament, Commerce Lab in collaboration with Commerce Study Circle, has organized Live Screening of Union Budget 2019 for faculties and students.
- 3) **Commerce Crossword:** Commerce Lab in coordination with Commerce Study Circle organizes an activity of commerce Crosswords for students. Commerce Study Circle has also organized a competition of Commerce Crossword in co-ordination with M.Com. Department.
- 4) **G. S. Quiz Club:** This year Commerce Study Circle has identified the students interested to participate in various quiz competitions and established a “G. S. Quiz Club”. A team consisting of members of G. S. Quiz Club has participated and won 2nd Prize in “Yuvarang” - Annual Event of RTM Nagpur University.
- 5) **Workshop on E-filing of Income Tax Returns and use of Statistical Softwares:** Commerce Study Circle and Commerce Lab has organized a workshop on e-filing of income tax returns for students in order to demonstrate the practical procedure of e-filing of income tax and TDS returns. The later part of the session covered use of various statistical softwares (Such as MS-Excel Tool pack, R etc.) in research.
- 6) **Launch of New Value-Added Course:** This year Commerce Study Circle has launched new course of Certifications by National Institute of Securities Markets (NISM). This year we have offered three modules under this course to the students:
 - 1) NISM Series V – A: Mutual Funds Distributor’s Certification
 - 2) NISM Series VIII: Equity Derivatives Certification
 - 3) NISM Series XIV – Research Analyst Certification
- 7) **Launch of Online Moodle Course:** Commerce Study Circle in coordination with commerce Lab has launched online Moodle course for two value addition courses viz., TCS-BPS (Finance

& Accounts) Program and for NISM Courses. In these online courses, a portal has been made available to students. Students who has enrolled for the courses has been provided with Unique Username and Passwords for accessing the portal. The portal has been used to provide reference eBooks, regulars assignments and activities to the students from time to time.

9) Academic Blog: The academic blog published by Commerce Lab has been used in the current academic sessions for providing assignments, notes and model answers, tutorials, important links, RSS feeds etc. This may help to increase awareness about blogging among the students and make them aware about the practical knowledge.

10) Google Classroom: As digital innovation initiative, Google Classroom platform has been used by teachers for sharing notes, assignments, tutorials, important links etc. of their respective subjects with the students. This has resulted in fast sharing of information with the students and students are also aware about such online platform.

11) Value Addition Courses: Students enrolled for various Value Addition Courses during the year as follows:

- 1) National Stock Exchange’s Certification in Financial Markets (NCFM) – 10 students
- 2) National Institute of Securities Markets (NISM) Certifications – 10 students
- 3) TCS-BPS (Finance & Accounts) – 31 students

The final course end examinations of these courses are due in the month of May – 2019.

12) Presentations on Recent Topics: The commerce study circle has scheduled power point presentations for students enrolled for TCS-BPS Batch for the academic year 2018-2019 in the month of March 2019, after the end of their course. Under TCS-BPS Batch students undergo 3 months training for learning Business Process Services module which is operating at TCS. After training students appear for Course end examination. Students who cleared exam successfully becomes due for placements.

13) Interactive Lecture in TCS – BPS (F & A) Class: An interactive session has been arranged for the students enrolled for the course of TCS – BPS (F & A).

14) Interactive Session on Resume Building and interview Preparation: A session was organized by Commerce Study Circle in coordination with Placement Cell on “Resume Building” and “Interview Preparation” on 30th March 2019. Mr. Maharshi Vyas was invited for this Guest Lecture. He has introduced students to various nitty gritty of resume building and conducted a mock interview to explain common mistakes made by students during the placements.

15) TCS – BPS (F & A) Course End Examination: The TCS – BPS (F & A) Course End Examination was held on 12th April 2019 at 02.00 p.m. to 04.00 p.m. Out of 31 students enrolled for the Course, 24 students have appeared for the exam. The students who will clear the examination will be eligible for the placements which may be due in the month of April - May 2019.
