1. Details of the Activities Conducted:

The Commerce Study Circle has organized various events in online as well as offline mode as students were not present in the Institution for most of the time of an academic year due to COVID-19 pandemic.

The main aim of setting up a commerce lab is to facilitate students an environment for making experiments of theories and economics laws. To create such environment, the lab has conducted following activities during the academic session 2021-2022:

1) Orientation of Value Addition Courses: Orientation program is organized in online mode through zoom meeting platform for explaining the importance of Value Addition Programmes in career planning and making them aware about various Value Addition Programmes conducted by college in collaboration with various Institutions and Industries. Over 100 students participated in the programme.

2) Arthashastra – The Economics Society:

- a) Live Screening of Union Finance Budget 2022: Live session of Union Finance Budget 2022 is screened during the online session to the students, and they are asked to prepare a short video about their interpretations about the Finance Budget 2022.
- b) Session on Budget Analysis: Budget Analysis session was organized by Department of Economics to discuss the potential impact of Budget on the Indian economy. During the session, Chief Guest, Shri. Nilesh Sathe, Ex-Member, IRDA, Guest of Honour, CA Shri. Jaydeep Shah, Ex-President, ICAI and Shri. Sanjay Bhargava, Chairman, Shiksha Mandal, Wardha expressed their opinions about the Union Budget.

Dr. Shubhangi D. Morey, Chairman, Board of Studies in Economics and Prof. Akash S. Jain, Convener, Commerce Study Circle made a brief presentation on highlights of Union Budget 2022. Recorded videos of students sharing their views on budget were also presented during the session.

Dr. N. Y. Khandait, Principal, G. S. College of Commerce & Economics, Nagpur thanked the guests for sharing their expert analytical views.

 c) Commerce Crossword Competition: Members of The Economics Society has organized a Crossword Competition on the theme of various terms in Economics.
58 Students from various departments and courses participated in the Competition.

3) Arbitrageurs - The Investor's Club:

- a) Training of N-SMART Simulator: A webinar of Shri. Deepak Garg, Deputy Manager, NSE Ltd. for training of NSMART portal was organized in collaboration with National Stock Exchange (NSE) Academy Webinar for TRADE-A-THON - National Live Stock Trading Contest.
- **b) TRADE-A-THON:** The investors club has encouraged students to participate in "TRADE-A-THON" A National Live Stock Trading Contest organized by National Stock Exchange.

14 students have participated in the contest. 3 of them have secured position in Top 100 contestants across India.

- 4) Triviatrix The Quiz Club:
 - a) Nation-Wide Financial Markets Quiz Contest: Over 200 students from college has participated in Nation-Wide Financial Markets Quiz Contest organised by National Institute of Securities Markets (NISM) in collaboration with Securities Exchange Board of India (SEBI).
 - **b) Inter-Collegiate Quiz Competition:** 2 teams (3 participants each) from the college has participated in the inter-collegiate quiz competition organized by Sindhu Mahavidyalaya, Nagpur. 1 of the teams has secured first position.
- 5) Value Addition Courses: Students enrolled for various Value Addition Courses during the year as follows:
 - National Institute of Securities Markets (NISM) Certifications Total 9 students enrolled or various modules such as Mutual Fund Distributors Certification, Equity Derivatives Certification etc.
 - 2) TCS-BPS (Finance & Accounts) 40 students have enrolled for the course. They are undergoing training right now. Their course end examination will be held in the month of May 2022 followed by the placement drive.

Activities Conducted:

- a) Workshop on Capital Markets: AIP TCS, Nagpur has organized a online workshop on Capital Markets for B.Com. and BBA Students. Over 100 students participated in the workshop. The workshop was conducted by the Subject Matter Expert (SME) from TCS, Nagpur. The workshop was aimed at to help Teaching faculties update themselves on contemporary industry knowledge and students in preparing themselves to be better equipped for job opportunities in TCS Nagpur and job opportunities in BFS (Banking, Financial Services) industry at large.
- **b)** Online Discussion Session with TCS Delivery Centre Head: The online discussion session was organized by TCS Nagpur for the discussion regarding leveraging TCS offerings and Capabilities in terms of talent in Nagpur region with Academia. TCS Delivery Centre Head, Mr. Arvind Kumar interacted with the teachers and trainers across Nagpur Region.
- 6) Online Classroom Activities: Online classroom activities such as quizzes related to subject, group discussions etc. are conducted for the students.
- 7) Google Classroom: As digital innovation initiative, Google Classroom platform has been used by teachers for sharing notes, assignments, tutorials, important links etc. of their respective subjects with the students. This has resulted in fast sharing of information with the students and students are also aware about such online platform.



2. Students Involved/Response:


