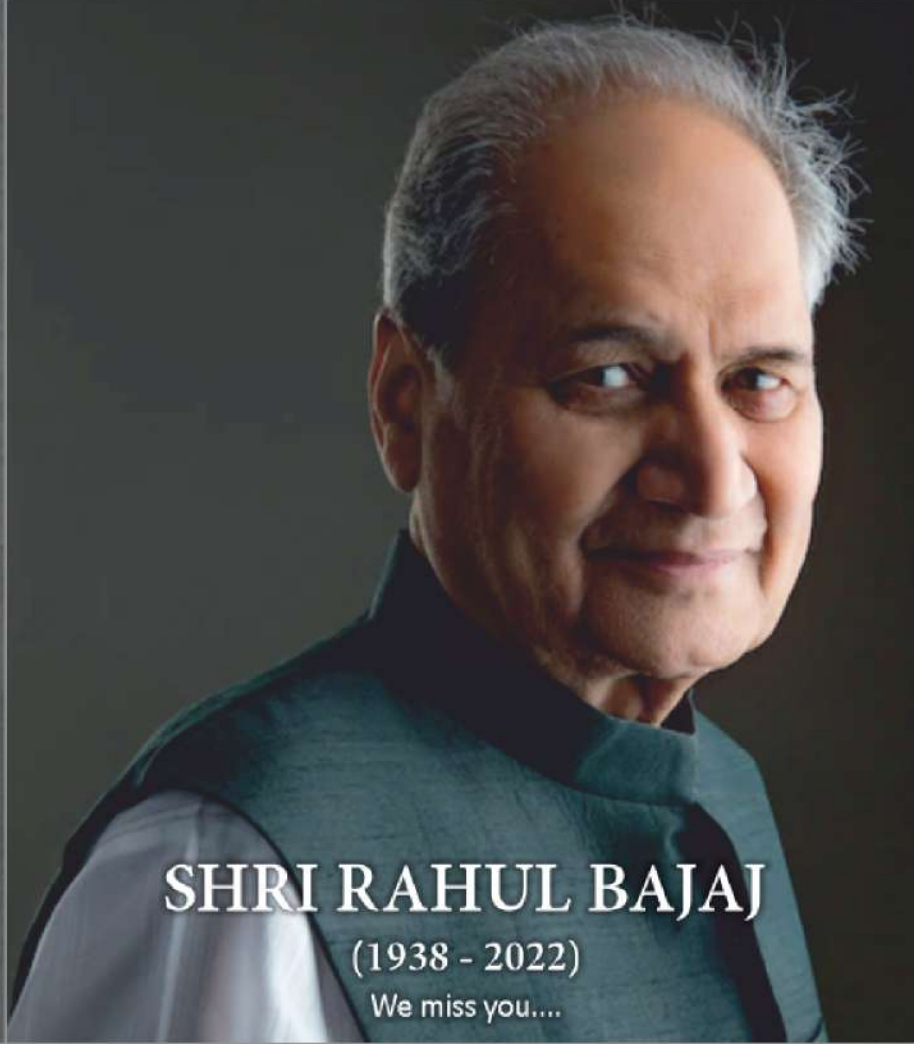

सम्पादकीय

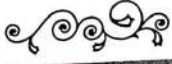

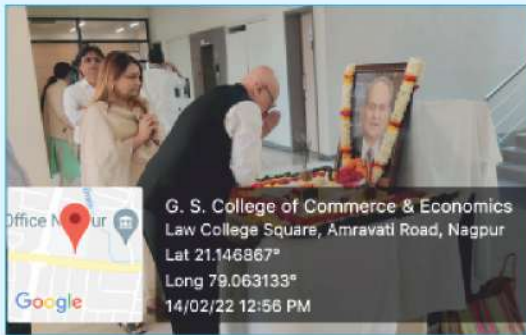

Rahul Bajaj – A Tribute to the Legendary Entrepreneur

What do you remember when I say the name 'Bajaj' ?

I am sure you recall the 'Chetak' scooter.

You know, when I was 5 years, me and my father used to go on a long drive on the iconic Chetak scooter. After years, when my father decided to buy a new bike he said “ no matter what choices we have, we will buy Bajaj only”. This is how the Bajaj group had instilled trust in all of us. But the overwhelming success of Bajaj group was not overnight and also not magical. It was due to the sheer hardwork, planning and confidence of one of the greatest entrepreneurs of our times, the charismatic Mr. Rahul Bajaj.

Shri. Rahul Bajaj was born on 10 June 1938. His parents were Shri Kamalnayan and Smt. Savitri Bajaj. During that time, the Bajaj group was third generation into business commodities trading. He completed his schooling from Cathedral and John Conon school, Mumbai and thereafter graduated in Economics, from St. Stephen's College, Delhi. Later he joined his family business, Bajaj Electricals as Junior purchase officer. He used to attend lectures at the Government Law School in morning and then moved to work in Bajaj Electricals. He knew that he would have to run the company with competence and professionalism. Therefore he decided to go for further studies and went to Harvard in 1962 to study Business Management. He finished his education in 1964 and returned to India . He joined Bajaj Auto as Deputy Manager incharge of the commercial function of the Company under the guidance of Naval Firodia.

One of the qualities of Rahul Bajaj was that he worked very hard to reach the top. In spite of being the Owner's son, he was given no concession when he joined the business. He learned every aspect of business and involved himself in all the departments like finance , sales ,purchase, marketing , audit, etc. After the death of his father he became the sole leader of the company. Rahul Bajaj had a great foresight to assess the markets for new ventures and he expanded into new businesses including cement, electrical appliances and scooters .He exponentially increased the Company's revenues. The company launched it's most iconic scooter Bajaj Chetak and within few years it became one of the most popular and loved two-wheelers in the country. For rising aspirations of middle class, Bajaj Chetak was a matter of pride and this trust continued for years. The iconic tune “Hamara Bajaj” became synonymous with customer's hopes of a better future in the 1980-90s. His pet project, the Bajaj Chetak Scooter, was a huge success story.

As life is never a smooth journey, Rahul Bajaj too faced many low points in his life. Parting ways with Firodia and the Italian Automobile major Piaggio was a difficult time.

When the Bajaj Group fell foul of the Government, the Company suffered as they were not allowed to expand their facilities to meet the growing demand. The Union-related problem at his factory, which turned violent also raised questions about the style of management that the Bajaj Group followed. But the high points in his life over shadowed the others. Today, Bajaj has a 60% market share in the World's two-wheeler market. Rahul Bajaj's pioneering efforts have made Bajaj Auto the fourth largest two-wheeler Manufacturer in the world.

Rahul Bajaj served twice as the President of the Confederation of Indian Industry(CII) and once at the Society of Indian Automobile Manufacturers (SIAM). In 2001 Rahul Bajaj was awarded with Padma Bhushan, the third highest civilian honour in the country. He was also the former chairman of the International Business Council, World Economic Forum and a former member of the South Asia advisory board of Harvard Business School.

Bajaj group has contributed immensely in the health care as well as educational sector. Kamalnayan Bajaj hospital, Shiksha Mandal, Gandhi Gyan Mandir and many more ventures were under his presidency. Rahul Bajaj's penchant for imparting quality education to students in this part of the world , encouraged Shiksha Mandal to start Bajaj Institute of Technology at Wardha, modelled on the lines of the best technical Institutes. The Bajaj group has also contributed in the fields of arts, science, medical, polytechnic and agriculture to provide the best education to the youth of India. Shri Rahul Bajaj contributed immensely to the economy of India. His penchant for providing quality education to youth,his contribution to many social causes, his outspoken views on many debatable issues, makes him class apart from others. This great entrepreneur and dynamic leader passed away for his heavenly abode on 12th February,2022.

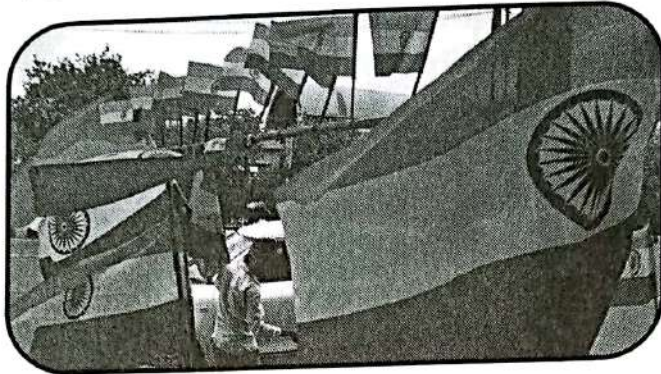

75 Years of Indian Independence



India completed its 75 years of independence on August 15, 2021, with usual pride to mark its freedom from British rule. The Indian independence movement began during World War-I and was led by Mohandas Karamchand Gandhi. On August 15, 1947, India got its freedom, ending an almost 200-year British rule.

About the History of India's independence:

The Indian independence Bill was introduced in the British House of Commons on July 4, 1947, and passed within a fortnight. It provided for the end of British rule in India on August 15, 1947. After that, India became a free country with the bifurcation of India and Pakistan. Some of the great freedom fighters who helped in India's freedom struggle include Mahatma Gandhi, Jawaharlal Nehru, Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel, Bhagat Singh, Chandra Shekhar Azad, Subhash Chandra Bose and many more.

Significance of India's Independence Day

India's Independence Day is significant as it stands as a reminder of the sacrifices that many freedom fighters made to get independence from British rule. It is a national festival and it is usually observed throughout the nation with the hoisting of the tricolour, parades and cultural events. India's first prime minister Jawaharlal Nehru hoisted the Indian national flag above the Lahori Gate of Red Fort in Delhi on August 15, 1947. It is a tradition that has since been followed by the incumbent Prime Minister, followed by an address to the country.

Facts about India's Independence Day

- The song 'Bharoto Bhagya Bidhata' composed in 1911 by Nobel Laureate Rabindranath Tagore was renamed as 'Jana gana Mana' and adopted by the constituent assembly of India as the national anthem on January 24, 1950.
- The Indian National Flag with the three horizontal stripes of saffron, white and green was hoisted on August 7, 1906, at Parsee Bagan Square in Kolkata. The first variant of India's current national flag was designed by freedom fighter Pingali Venkayya in 1921. The current flag of India was officially adopted on July 22, 1947.
- Five other countries celebrate their independence on August 15 along with India.

They are Bahrain, North Korea, South Korea and Liechtenstein.

- The Indian Flag is manufactured and supplied from only one place in the Nation. The Karnataka Khadi Gramodyoga Samyukta Sangha, located in Dharwad in Karnataka, has the authority to manufacture and supply the Indian National Flag. According to the Bureau of India Standards (BIS), the flag is manufactured only with hand-spun and hand woven cotton khadi wafting.

India Rising what does it mean to world :

India has established relations with world powers such as Great Britain, the European Union, Japan, Russia, and the United States. It houses one-sixth of the world's population, maintains a unique democratic ethos, and pursues a foreign policy of national interests and solidarity with developing countries. India has invested heavily in its relations with neighboring countries, including China, to create a favorable environment for economic growth.



The present economic growth of India - the fastest-growing major economy in 2015 - 2021 has increased its standing on the world stage, and it is now the most advanced country and performing strongly. Its economy is also the second-largest in the world regarding purchasing power parity, giving it more significant global clout and power by expanding and modernizing its military capabilities.

India has 5000+ years old history, 1/6th of the landmass, and almost five times the USA's population. India's challenges are 1000 times more complex. India is the largest exporter of intellectual brainpower to the entire world. Celebrating India's Independence Day should not deter the spirit from imagining a powerful, prosperous, and peaceful India in 2047, when India celebrates 100 years of independence.

As India enters its 75th year of independence, there are many reasons to be cautiously optimistic about its place in the world. Since independence, India has reclaimed its progressive school of thought, namely democracy, secularism, law, respect for human rights, rational and deductive thinking, and science and technology development. On the other hand, India has proved to be a "bridge between the many extremes of the world".

India, home to many traditions and the largest and most vibrant democracy, has won the most medals in 121 years of Olympic participation.

Let us celebrate 'Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav' with great pride.

He received bullet wound in a firing by the police on August 22, 1942 and he died on the same day. UNSUNG HERO - KHUDIRAM BOSE

Khudiram Bose was an Indian revolutionary from Bengal Presidency who opposed British rule of India. For his role in the Muzaffarpur Conspiracy Case, along with Prafulla Chaki, he was sentenced to death and subsequently executed, making him one of the youngest martyrs of the Indian Independence Movement.

Khudiram, along with Prafulla Chaki, attempted to assassinate a British judge, Magistrate Douglas Kingsford, by throwing bombs on the carriage they suspected the man was in. Magistrate Kingsford, however, was seated in a different carriage, and the throwing of bombs resulted in the deaths of two British women. Prafulla fatally shot himself before the arrest. Khudiram was arrested and trialed for the murder of the two women, ultimately being sentenced to death. He was one of the first freedom fighters in Bengal to be executed by Britishers

At the time of his hanging, Khudiram was 18 years, 8 months, and 11 days, 10 hours old making him one of the second youngest revolutionaries in India

Mahatma Gandhi, however, denounced the violence, lamenting the deaths of the two innocent women. He stated "that the Indian people will not win their freedom through these methods. Bal Gangadhar Tilak, in his newspaper Kesari, defended the two young men and called for immediate swaraj. This was followed by the immediate arrest of Tilak by the British colonial government on charges of sedition

Khudiram Bose was born on 3 December 1889 in a kayastha family in the small village named Mohobani, situated under the Keshpur Police Station in the Medinipur district of Bengal. His father was a Tehsildar in the Nerajol.

Khudiram was the fourth child in a family of three daughters. His parents, Trailokyanath Bose and Lakshmi Priya Devi had two sons before the birth of Khudiram but both of them died prematurely. Following the traditional customs prevalent in the culture, the newborn child was symbolically sold to his eldest sister in exchange of three handfuls of food grains locally known as Khud, in an attempt to save him from dying at an early age. This way he acquired the name, Khudiram

He lost his mother when he was six years old. His father died a year after. Aparupa Roy, his elder sister, brought him to her house at Hatgachha village under the Daspur Police Station. Aparupa's husband, Amritalal Roy, got him admitted to Tamluk's Hamilton High School

In 1902 and 1903, Sri Aurobindo and Sister Nivedita visited Midnapore. They held a series of public lectures and private sessions with the existing revolutionary groups for freedom. Khudiram, a teenager, was an active participant in the discussions

about the revolution.

Apparently, he joined Anushilan Samiti, and came into contact with the network of Barindra Kumar Ghosh of Calcutta. He became a volunteer at the age of 15, and was arrested for distributing pamphlets against the British rule in India. At the young age of 16, Khudiram took part in planting bombs near the police stations and targeted government officials.

After martyrdom, Khudiram became so popular that weavers of Bengal started weaving a special type of dhoti, with 'Khudiram' written on its side. Boys studying in school colleges wore these dhotis and walked on the path of independence. Khudiram Bose is considered to be the first fighter to sacrifice his life in the Indian freedom struggle.

रानी चेंन्नम्मा भारत की पहली महिला स्वतंत्रता कार्यकर्ता थीं। वह ब्रिटिश साम्राज्य के खिलाफ एक जीवंत उग्र निगाहों के साथ अकेली खड़ी थी। रानी चेंन्नम्मा उन्हें भगाने में सफल नहीं हुईं, लेकिन उन्होंने कई महिलाओं को ब्रिटिश शासन के खिलाफ संघर्ष करने के लिए उकसाया। वह कर्नाटक में कित्तूर रियासत की चेंन्नम्मा रानी थीं। आज वह कित्तूर रानी चेंन्नम्मा के नाम से जानी जाती हैं।

• प्रारंभिक जीवन -

रानी चेंन्नम्मा का जन्म १७७८ में काकाती (कर्नाटक में बेलगाम के उत्तर में एक छोटा सा गाँव) में हुआ था, जो झॉंसी की रानी लक्ष्मी बाई से लगभग ५६ साल पहले हुआ था। बहुत छोटी उम्र से ही उन्होंने घुडसवारी, तलवारबाजी और तीरंदाजी का प्रशिक्षण प्राप्त किया। वह अपने शहर में अपने बहादुर कृत्यों के लिए जानी जाती थी।

रानी चेंन्नम्मा का विवाह १५ वर्ष की आयु में कित्तूर के शासक मल्लसरजा देसाई से हुआ था। १८१६ में उनके पति की मृत्यु के बाद उनका वैवाहिक जीवन एक दुःखद कहानी प्रतीत होता था। इस विवाह के साथ उनका केवल एक बेटा था, लेकिन भाग्य ने एक दुखद खेल खेला। उसके बेटे ने १९२४ में अंतिम सांस ली।

• अंग्रेजों के खिलाफ युद्ध -

रानी चेंन्नम्मा और स्थानीय लोगों ने अंग्रेजों की मनमानी का कडा विरोध किया। ठाकरे ने कित्तूर पर आक्रमण किया। उस लड़ाई में ठाकरे के साथ सैकड़ों ब्रिटिश सैनिक मारे गए। एक छोटे से शासक के हाथों पराज्य का अपमान अंग्रेजों के लिए इतना भारी था कि उसे निगला नहीं जा सकता था। वे मैसूर और शोलापुर से बड़ी सेना लेकर आए और कित्तूर को घेर लिया। चेंन्नम्मा को युद्ध की घोषणा करने के लिए मजबूर होना पड़ा। १२ दिनों के लिए, बहादुर रानी

और उसके सैनिकों ने अपने किले की रक्षा की, लेकिन जैसा कि सामान्य विशेषता है, देशद्रोही घुस गए और तोपों में बारूद में मिट्टी और गोबर मिला दिया। रानी की हार हुई (१८२४ ई.) उसे बंदी बना लिया गया और जीवन न जी सकीं, लेकिन उन्होंने इतिहास की दुनिया में कई शताब्दियों तक अपनी उपस्थिति दर्ज कराई।

• कारावास और मृत्यु -

रानी चेन्नम्मा का बैलहोंगल किले में कैद कर दिया गया था जहाँ उन्होने अपना समय पवित्र पुस्तकों को पढ़ने में बिताया। समय के साथ उनका स्वास्थ्य बिगड़ने लगा और उन्होंने अंततः २१ फरवरी १८२९ को अंतिम सांस ली। उनके संघर्ष ने उनके लेफ्टिनेंट को प्रेरित किया जो उनकी ओर से अंग्रेजों के खिलाफ लड़ते रहे। बाद में उन्हें भी अंग्रेजों ने पकड़ लिया और फांसी पर लटका दिया।

• रानी चेन्नम्मा को श्रद्धांजलि -

हर साल, किचूर २२ से २४ अक्टूबर तक रानी चेन्नम्मा के नाम पर किचूर उत्सव मनाता है। महारानी के सम्मान में, पूर्व राष्ट्रपति प्रतिभा पाटिल ने ११ सितंबर २००७ को भारतीय संसद परिसर के सामने उनकी एक प्रतिमा का अनावरण किया। बंगलोर और किचूर में भी दो अन्य प्रतिमाएं स्थापित की गईं। बैंगलोर और कोल्हापुर के बीच एक दैनिक ट्रेन का नाम रानी के नाम पर रानी चेन्नम्मा एक्सप्रेस रखा गया। उनके जीवन को भी बीआर पंथुलु द्वारा एक ऐतिहासिक ड्रामा फिल्म के रूप में फिल्म में कैद किया गया था। फिल्म का नाम किचुरु चेन्नम्मा है।

भावपूर्ण श्रद्धांजलि स्वर कोकिला लता मंगेशकर

‘नाम गुम जायेगा चेहरा ये बदल जायेगा मेरी आवाज ही मेरी पहचान है....’

‘भारत रत्न’ लता मंगेशकर वह शख्सियत हैं, जिन्होंने अपने साठ साल से अधिक के गायन कैरियर में बीस से अधिक भाषाओं में तीस हजार से अधिक गाने गाये हैं। उनके द्वारा गाया गया हर गीत अपने आप में अनूठा है। वह भारत की सर्वाधिक लोकप्रिय एवं सम्माननीय गायिका हैं।

‘स्वर कोकिला’ के नाम से मशहूर लता मंगेशकर का जन्म २८ सितम्बर, १९२९ को मध्य प्रदेश के इन्दौर शहर में एक मध्यमवर्गीय मराठी परिवार में हुआ था। उनके पिता पंडित दीनानाथ मंगेशकर संगीत प्रिय एवं थियेटर से जुड़े व्यक्ति थे, इसलिए उन्होंने अपनी बड़ी बेटी लता को पाँच वर्ष की उम्र से ही संगीत की शिक्षा देनी शुरू की। संगीत की ओर अधिक रुझान के कारण लताजी की औपचारिक शिक्षा ठीक से नहीं हो सकी।

उन्होंने पाँच वर्ष की उम्र से ही अपने पिता के साथ एक रंगमंच कलाकार के रूप में अभिनय करना शुरू कर दिया था। इसी बीच वर्ष १९४२ में जब उनकी उम्र मात्र १३ वर्ष थी, उनके पिता की हृदय की बिमारी के कारण मृत्यु हो गई और परिवार में सबसे बड़ी होने के कारण परिवार की जिम्मेदारी उन पर आ गई। इस उद्देश्य को पूरा करने के लिए उन्होंने वर्ष १९४२ से १९४८ बीच हिन्दी और मराठी की लगभग आठ फिल्मों में एक बाल कलाकार के रूप में अभिनय किया। १३ वर्ष की आयु में ही उन्होंने फिल्मों के लिए गाना शुरू कर दिया। उन्होंने अपना पहला गाना मराठी फिल्म ‘किती हसाल’ (कितना हँसोगे) के लिए गाया, किन्तु इस गाने को फिल्म से निकाल दिया गया।

अभिनेत्री के रूप में उनकी पहली फिल्म ‘पाहिली मंगलागौर’ (१९४२) रही। उस्ताद बडे गुलाम अली खाँ ने जब लता को गाते हुए सुना, तो उन्हें तीन मिनट की जादूगरनी’ कहा।

राष्ट्रधन

उनके द्वारा गाया गैर-फिल्मी देशभक्ति गीत 'ऐ मेरे वतन के लोगो' उनके सर्वाधिक प्रसिद्ध एवं लोकप्रिय गीतों में से एक है। कहा जाता है कि एक बार किसी समारोह में जब तत्कालीन प्रधानमंत्री ने इस गाने को सुना था, तो उनकी आँखों से आंसू निकल पड़े थे और उन्होंने उनकी प्रशंसा की थी।

वर्ष १९७४ में उन्होंने दुनिया में सर्वाधिक गीत गाने का 'गिनीज बुक ऑफ वर्ल्ड रिकॉर्ड' बनाया। वर्ष १९७४ में ही लन्दन के रॉयल एल्बर्ट में उनकी आवाज को कम्प्यूटर की मदद से जाँचा गया तथा विश्व में सर्वश्रेष्ठ-पाया गया। लता जी इस हॉल में प्रदर्शन करने वाली पहली भारतीय महिला बनीं।

संगीत-जगत् को उनकी देन को देखते हुए उन्हें अब तक कई पुरस्कारों से सम्मानित किया गया है। उन्होंने वर्ष १९५८, १९६२, १९६५, १९६९, १९९३ एवं १९९४ में कुल मिलाकर छः बार फिल्मफेयर पुरस्कार प्राप्त किए। वे गायन के लिए तीन बार वर्ष १९७२, १९७५ एवं १९९० में राष्ट्रीय पुरस्कारों से सम्मानित की जा चुकी हैं। भारत सरकार ने उन्हें वर्ष १९६९ में पद्म भूषण से अलंकृत किया। वर्ष १९८४-८५ में मध्य प्रदेश सरकार ने उनके नाम पर 'लता मंगेशकर अवार्ड' देना शुरू किया।

भारतीय फिल्मों में उनके योगदान को देखते हुए वर्ष १९८९ में उन्हें 'दादा साहेब फाल्के पुरस्कार' से सम्मानित किया गया। वर्ष १९९७ में उन्हें 'राजीव गांधी पुरस्कार' से सम्मानित किया गया। भारत सरकार ने वर्ष १९९९ में उन्हें पद्म विभूषण से अलंकृत किया। इसके बाद वर्ष २००० में आईफा एवं वर्ष २००१ में स्टारडस्ट ने भी उन्हें 'लाइफ टाइम अचीवमेंट पुरस्कार' प्रदान किये।

भारत सरकार ने उनकी उपलब्धियों को देखते हुए वर्ष २००१ में देश के सर्वोच्च पुरस्कार 'भारत रत्न' से सम्मानित किया। लता मंगेशकर ने अपने जीवन के संस्मरणों को पुस्तक का रूप दे दिया है, जो 'फुले वेचिता' (फूल चुनते-चुनते) नाम से मराठी भाषा में प्रकाशित है। यह उनकी पुस्तक है, जो वर्ष १९९७ में विशेष चर्चित पुस्तक रही।

लताजी बॉलीवुड की सर्वाधिक लोकप्रिय हस्ती रही हैं और आगे भी उनके द्वारा गाए गए गीतों की मधुर गूँज लोगों को अपना दीवाना बनाती रहेगी। वे सदा मानव समुदाय के लिए सेवा करने के अवसरों की तलाश में रहती। लता मंगेशकर भारतीय संगीत में एक अनुपम व अनुकरणीय व्यक्तित्व हैं, जिनके योगदान को अमरता प्राप्त हो चुकी है। विश्व का संगीत जगत् सदा लता मंगेशकर जी का ऋणी रहेगा।

स्वर कोकिला लता मंगेशकर का ९२ साल की उम्र में रविवार सुबह निधन हो गया। भारत सरकार की ओर से लता जी के सम्मान में दो दिन का राष्ट्रीय शोक घोषित किया गया है। उनका जाना देश के लिए अपूरणीय क्षति है। वे सभी संगीत साधकों के लिए सदैव प्रेरणा थी। लता जी प्रखर देशभक्त थीं। उनका जीवन अनेक उपलब्धियों से भरा रहा है। लता जी हमेशा ही अच्छे कामों के लिए हम सभी को प्रेरणा देती रही हैं।

कोरोना काल में निःशुल्क शिक्षा अभियान में मेरा अनुभव

कोरोना काल में तालाबंदी के चलते सभी क्षेत्र बुरी तरह प्रभावित हुए उद्योग, समाज और अर्थव्यवस्था अस्त-व्यस्त हो गया। कोरोना महामारी को नियंत्रण में लाने के लिए सरकार ने तालाबंदी की नीति अपनाई। जिसके चलते भीड़ वाले इलाके-सिनेमाघर, बाजार, शॉपिंग मॉल, ऑफिस आदि को बंद करने के साथ-साथ अध्ययन क्षेत्र स्कूल-कॉलेजों को भी बंद कर दिया गया। परिणामतः विद्यार्थियों का विकास थम सा गया। शिक्षा के क्षेत्र की बाधाओं को बढ़ते देख प्रशासन ने ऑनलाइन माध्यम से शिक्षा का प्रसार किया। लेकिन ग्रामीण परिवेश और निम्न वर्ग के लिए महँगी ऑनलाइन शिक्षा आसान नहीं थी।

समाज में शिक्षा की इस स्थिति को देखकर मैंने एक 'निःशुल्क शिक्षा' अभियान शुरू किया जिसके अंतर्गत मैंने उन विद्यार्थियों का मुफ्त शिक्षा देने संकल्प किया जो निर्धन परिवार से थे, जिनके माता-पिता ऑनलाइन पढ़ाई का खर्च उठाने में असमर्थ थे।

मैंने वर्ष २०२०-२०२१ में वसंतराव नाइक वसाहत, धरमपेठ में एक अभियान चलाया। धरमपेठ के गरीब एवं जरूरतमंद विद्यार्थियों को ऑनलाइन शिक्षा प्राप्त संभव नहीं था। बच्चे पढ़ाई छोड़कर खेल-कूद में अपना समय बर्बाद करते थे। यह सब देखकर मैंने गरीब विद्यार्थियों के लिए एक पहल सोची और यहाँ के ४-५ विद्यार्थियों को मुफ्त शिक्षा देने का फैसला किया जिससे कि इन विद्यार्थियों का ऑनलाइन शिक्षा न ले पाने के कारण कोई नुकसान न हो।

मैंने इन बच्चों को मुलभूत शिक्षा देने का प्रयास किया है, इसमें उन्हें सामान्यज्ञान, इतिहास, हिंदी, अंग्रेजी, गणित और चित्रकला आदि विषय पढ़ाने का प्रयास किया है। बच्चों ने शुरुवात में अच्छा प्रतिसाद नहीं दिया परंतु समय के साथ उन्होंने सभी प्रकार के कार्यक्रमों में सहभाग लिया। उनके अन्दर की कला को बाहर लाने के लिए कई प्रकार के उपक्रम चलाये उनके लिए गायन, नृत्य, नाट्य, चित्रकला, निबंध स्पर्धा जैसे कार्यक्रम आयोजित किया जिनमें उन्होंने उत्साह पूर्ण सहभाग लिया।

इस कार्य के दौरान मैंने अनुभव किया कि, कोरोना महामारी के चलते लोग बहुत डरे हुए थे, ऐसे में वे अपने बच्चों को घर से बाहर भेजने के लिए राजी नहीं थे, चाहे वह पढ़ाई ही क्यों न हों, उन लोगों को मैंने उनके घर जाकर कोरोना के रोकथाम के उपायों से परिचित कराया, शुरु में काफी दिक्कतें हुईं लेकिन बहुत समझाने के बाद वे समझने लगे इसके साथ साथ, बच्चों को कोरोना महामारी के खतरे के बारे में ज्यादा जानकारी नहीं थी ऐसे में उन्हें कोरोना के रोकथाम के उपाय समझना साथ ही उनके शरारतों को समझदारी में बदलना थोड़ा मुश्किल काम था। स्कूल-कॉलेज बंद होने से विद्यार्थियों का मन पढ़ाई से हट चूका था, उनका मन पढ़ाई की तरफ पुनः आकर्षित करना

काफी मुश्किल था। बच्चों का मन पढाई में लगे रहे और वे और ज्यादा मेहनत करें', इसके लिए मैंने पढाई में उत्तम प्रदर्शन करने वाले बच्चों को परीक्षा के माध्यम से पुरस्कृत करना शुरू किया। बच्चों के व्यक्तित्व विकास और सामान्य जानकारी हेतु हमने पढाई के साथ - साथ अन्य गतिविधियाँ भी ली, जिनमें उनकी कला का विकास हो। पर्यावरण से जोड़ने के लिए उनके साथ वृक्षारोपण कर उन्हें उसका संवर्धन व संरक्षण सिखाया।

“निःशुल्क शिक्षा” अभियान के लिए प्रेरणा हमारे महाविद्यालय के राष्ट्रीय सेवा योजना विभाग के कार्यक्रम अधिकारी डॉ. ए.बी. पटले सर से मिली। उन्होंने इस अभियान के लिए समय - समय पर मार्गदर्शित किया। मैंने कोरोना से बचाव करने के लिए बच्चों को स्वास्थ्य और स्वच्छता से सम्बंधित पाठ भी पढाया। ताकि वे स्वच्छता का महत्व समझे और कोरोना महामारी के चपेट में आने से बचे। इस कार्य में सर का काफ़ी सहयोग प्राप्त हुआ। उन्हीं के मार्गदर्शन में मैंने यह नया अनुभव किया। काफ़ी कुछ नया सीखने को मिला। यह सब उनके मार्गदर्शन के कारण सफल हुआ। अपने इस अभियान से जुड़कर मैंने देने की प्रवृत्ति के संतोष का अनुभव किया।

पंडित माधवराव सप्रे की १५० वी जयंती

पंडित माधवराव सप्रे हिंदी साहित्यकार और पत्रकार भी थे। वे हिंदी के सर्वप्रथम कहानी लेखक के रूप में भी जाने जाते हैं। भारत के स्वतंत्रता संग्राम में भी उनकी अग्रणी अहम भूमिका थी। वह भारतीय स्वतंत्रता संग्राम आंदोलन के उस दौरान की पत्रकारिता थे जो साहित्य के साथ साथ संवेदना का स्पर्श को पाकर अधिक जनाहितैषी साबित हुई।

पंडित माधवराव सप्रे हिंदी के उन थोड़े से लेखकों में से हैं जिन्होंने हिंदी को समाज विज्ञान के विषयों और मुद्दों पर चिंतन और लेखक की भाषा बनाने का सफल प्रयास किया।

पंडित माधवराव सप्रे शासकीय नौकरी तहसीलदार के रूप में भी कार्यरत थे फिर भी अपनी नौकरी की परवाह न करते हुए आपने कर्मयोगी बनकर देशभक्ति करते हुए अग्रेजों को पछाड़ने दान दिया। उन्होंने सन १९०० में छत्तीसगढ़ मित्र नायक पत्रिका निकाली। यह पत्रिका देशभर में प्रसिद्ध हो गयी। २६ साल की उम्र में उन्होंने पत्रकारिता और साहित्य सेवा के मानक रचे १९२० में उन्होंने जबलपुर में हिंदी मंदिर की स्थापना की। १९२१ में रायपुर में राष्ट्रीय विद्यालय की स्थापना की और साथ ही पहली कथा विद्यालय जानकी देवी महिला पाठशाला की भी स्थापना की।

पंडित माधवराव सप्रे जी की कहानी एक टोकरी भर मिट्टी को हिंदी की पहली कहानी होने का श्रेय प्राप्त है। सप्रे जी ने मौलिक लोवन के साथ-साथ प्रसिद्ध संत रामदेव रामदास के मराठी में रचित दासबोध लोकमान्य तिलक के रचित गीतारहस्य आदि पुस्तकों का हिंदी में अनुवाद भी बहुत अच्छा किया।

पंडित माधवराव सप्रे की स्मृति में भोपाल में माधवरव सप्रे स्मृति समाचार पत्र संग्राहलय और शोध की स्थापना की गयी थी। अद्भुत व्यक्तित्व व कृतित्व के धनी पं. माधवराव सप्रे का योगदान हिंदी जगत को अविस्मरणीय हैं।

नरेश मेहता : शताब्दी वर्ष

प्रस्तावना :

आधुनिक हिन्दी साहित्य जगत् में नरेश मेहताजी कवि, कथाकार, गीतकार, नाटककार, चिन्तक, विचारक आदि रूपों में अपना विशिष्ट स्थान रखते हैं। वे नयी कविता के प्रयोगधर्मी अन्वेषक हैं।

सांस्कृतिक गौरव, परम्पराओं एवं मिथकीय सन्दर्भों के बीच सम्बन्धों को दर्शाती उनकी रचनाएं अपनी सृजनधर्मिता के वैशिष्ट्य से ओतप्रोत हैं। वे मानवीय उत्कर्ष के कवि हैं।

जीवन परिचय एवं रचनाकर्म:

कवि नरेश मेहता का जन्म १५ फरवरी १९२२ को शाजापुर (म.प्र.) में हुआ था। उन्होंने मैट्रिक की परीक्षा उज्जैन से उत्तीर्ण की। उच्च शिक्षा काशी विश्वविद्यालय से पूर्ण की। सन् १९४० में जब वे उज्जैन आये, तो भारतीय राजनीति एवं साहित्य सृजन में सदा समन्वय कायम रखा। जब वे काशी आये, तो उन्होंने अपने गुरु के रूप में केशवप्रसाद मिश्रजी को अपने मार्गदर्शक के रूप में पाया।

लेखन के साथ-साथ जीविका का माध्यम बना, ऑल इंडिया रेडियो में नौकरी करना। यहां नौकरी का बंधन उन्हें अधिक दिनों तक बांधे नहीं रह सका। वे स्वतंत्र लेखन की आशा में इलाहाबाद आ गये। कुछ समय पश्चात् उज्जैन के 'प्रेमचन्द सृजन पीठ' के निदेशक बनकर वहीं चले गये और वहीं बस गये।

उनकी प्रकाशित कृतियाः - "बन पाखी सुनो", "बोलने दो चीड़ को", समर्पित उकान्त", "उत्सवा तुम मेरा मौन हो", "अरण्या", "देखना एक दिन" इत्यादि कविता संग्रह हैं।

खण्डकाव्यों में :- "संशय की एक रात", महाप्रस्थान", शबरी", प्रार्थनापुरुष", तथा

उपन्यासों में :- डूबते मरुदूल", "नदी यशस्वी है", धूमकेतु एक श्रुति", प्रथम फाल्गुन", यह पथ बन्धु था", उत्तर कथा"।

कहानी संग्रह :- "एक समर्पित महिला", "तथापि", "जलसाघर"।

नाटक :- "सुबह के घंटे", "खंडित यात्राएं"।

एकांकी :- "सनोबर के फूल", "पिछली रात की बर्फ"।

संस्मरण :- "काव्य का वैष्णव व्यक्तित्व", "मुक्तिबोध एक अवधूत", शब्दपुरुष अज्ञेय", "साधु न चले जमात" आदि हैं।

उन्होंने "कृति" तथा "चौथा संसार" नामक पत्रिका का सम्पादन किया। उनकी समरत रचनाओं में आधुनिकता एवं परम्परावादिता की पुनर्व्याख्या मिलती है। वे मनुष्य को उच्चतम आकांक्षाओं के सूर्य के रूप में प्राणवान, ऊर्जावानही नहीं, शक्ति के प्रेरक मानते हैं।

उनके खंडकाव्य "एक संशय की रात" में उन्होंने भगवान् श्रीराम के उस अन्तर्द्वन्द्व को दर्शाया है; जब वे युद्धस्थल की ओर प्रयाण करते हुए विचार कर रहे हैं कि यह युद्ध किसके लिए लडा जा रहा है।

महज सीता के लिए! नहीं जनता के लिए लडा जा रहा है। इस पौराणिक मिथक को वे एक नये सन्दर्भों में देखते हैं। यही उनकी प्रयोगधर्मी, सृजनधर्मी सोच है।

उपसंहार:-

साहित्य में कुछ नया रचने वाले रचनाकारों में से एक थे: नरेश मेहताजी। वे मूलतः कवि थे। कवि होने के नाते उनकी रचनाओं में राग-विराग की वैयक्तिक, सामाजिक अनुभूतियां हैं। जीवन की प्रत्येक परिस्थितियों में मानवीय जीवन-बोध को तलाशती रहती हैं उनकी रचनाएं। ऐसे महान् लेखक २२ नवम्बर सन् २००० को हमारे बीच नहीं रहे।

मन्नू भंडारी हिंदी की सुप्रसिद्ध कहानीकार थी। मध्य प्रदेश में मंदसौर जिले के भानपुरा गाँव में जन्मी मन्नू का बचपन का नाम महेन्द्र कुमारी था। लेखन के लिए उन्होंने मन्नू नाम का चुनाव किया। उन्होंने एम.ए. तक शिक्षा पाई और वर्षों तक दिल्ली के मिरांडा हाउस में अध्यापिका रहीं। धर्मयुग में धारावाहिक रूप से प्रकाशित उपन्यास आपका बंटी से लोकप्रियता प्राप्त करने वाली मन्नू भंडारी विक्रम विश्वविद्यालय, उज्जैन में प्रेमचंद सृजनपीठ की अध्यक्ष भी रही।

मन्नू भंडारी इनका जन्म ३ अप्रैल १९३१ में हुआ। मन्नू भंडारी के पिता का नाम सुखसंपत राय था, जो कि स्वयं एक लेखक थे। मन्नू के परिवार में उनसे बड़े दो भाई और दो बहने भी थी। मन्नू भंडारी के पति का नाम राजेंद्र यादव था जो कि हिंदी लेखक तथा संपादक थे।

मन्नू भंडारी जी कि जैसे कि आपका बंटी, एक इंच मुस्कान, महाभोज मन्नू जी ने १९७१ में लिखा जिसमें उन्होंने विवाह विच्छेद की त्रासदी में पिस रहे एक बच्चे को केन्द्रित किया। मन्नू भंडारी इन्होंने अपने उपन्यासों और कविताओं में समाज से जुड़े कई विषयों पर प्रकाश डाला।

मन्नू भंडारी इन्हें कई पुरस्कार मिले।

अपने शब्दों से लोगों के मन में घर करने वाली मन्नू भंडारी इनकी मृत्यु १५ नवंबर २०२१ में हुई। पर इनके द्वारा लिखी गई कविताएँ, कहानीयाँ एवं उपन्यास आज भी जीवित हैं, और आगे भी समाज और विद्यार्थियों को प्रेरणा देंगे।

* कस्तूरबा गांधी :-

कस्तूरबा गांधी मोहनदास करमचंद गांधी के पत्नी थे। आजादी की लड़ाई में उन्होंने महात्मा गांधी का साथ दिया और उन्होंने हमारे देश को आजादी दिलाने में बहुत संघर्ष किया।

पण्डित भीमसेन जोशी : जन्म शताब्दी वर्ष

कर्नाटक के 'गडग जिला के एक छोटे से गांव' में फरवरी, १९२२ ई. को आधुनिक भारत के तानसेन कहे जाने वाले पण्डित भीमसेन जोशी का जन्म हुआ था। पण्डित भीमसेन जोशी जी का यह शताब्दी वर्ष है। उनके पिताजी 'गुरुराज जोशी' स्थानिया हायस्कूल के हेडमास्टर और कन्नड, अंग्रेजी और संस्कृत के विद्वान थे। उन्होंने १९ साल की उम्र में गायन शुरू किया था और वे सात दशको तक शास्त्रीय गायन करते रहे। पण्डित भीमसेन जोशी ने, न केवल कर्नाटक को बल्कि भारत को भी गौरवन्वित किया है। पण्डित भीमसेन जोशी को बचपन से ही संगीत का बहुत शौक था। पहले एलबम में मराठी और हिंदी भाषा के कुछ भक्ति गीत और भजन थे, इन्हे १९४२ में एच.एम.वी. में रिलीज किया था। बाद में १९४३ में पण्डित जोशी जी मुंबई चले गये और वहा पर रेडियो आर्टिस्ट के रूप में काम करने लगे। उन्हें गायन के ख्याल रूप के साथ-साथ भक्ति संगीत (भजन और अभंग) के अपने लोकप्रिय गायन के लिए जाना जाता है। पण्डित जोशी हिंदुस्तानी शास्त्रीय संगीत की किराना घराने की परंपरा से ताल्लुक रखते हैं।

भारत रत्न सम्मानित होने के बाद लिखे गये हिंदू लेख में कहा : पण्डित भीमसेन जोशी हमेशा पथिक थे, उन्होंने विचार-विमर्श के बजाये शानदार वाक्यांशो और तानो की अधिक सहजता से प्रस्तुत किया। जोशी कभी-कभी सरगम और तिहाई का इस्तेमाल करते थे और अक्सर किराना घराने की पारंपारिक रचनाए गाते थे। उनके संगीत ने अक्सर आश्चर्यजनक और अचानक वाक्यांशो को बदल दिया। पण्डित जोशी जी को २० से ज्यादा रागों पर पकड हासिल थी।

१९५३ में आर्य संगीत प्रसारक मंडल के साथ अपने गुरु गंधर्व की पहली पुण्यतिथी के अवसर पर पण्डित जोशी और उनके मित्र नानासाहेब देशपांडे ने अपने गुरु सवाई गंधर्व को श्रद्धांजलि के रूप में सवाई गंधर्व संगीत समारोह का आयोजन किया था। पण्डित जोशी को गैस्ट्रो इंटेस्टाइनल रक्तस्राव और द्विपक्षीय निमोनिया के साथ ३१ दिसंबर २०१० को सह्यादी सुपर स्पेशियलिटी अस्पताल में भर्ती कराया गया था। सांस लेने में तकलीफ के कारण उन्हें वेंटिलेटर सपोर्ट पर रखा गया था। उन्हें आक्षेप हुआ और अस्पताल में रहने के दौरान उन्हें डायलिसिस पर भी रखा गया था। हालांकि वेंटिलेटर से हटाए जाने के बाद वे तीन दिनों के लिए कुछ समय के लिए ठीक हो गए, लेकिन उसके बाद उनकी हालत बिगड गई। अपनी गायकी से दिल को छू लेने की कला रखने वाले शास्त्रीय संगीत सम्राट का निधन २४ जनवरी २०११ को ८८ वर्ष की उम्र में पुणे के एक निजी अस्पताल में हुआ। संगीत के ऐसे पुजारी पण्डित भीमसेन जोशी को मेरा शत-शत नमन।

“आपला बजाज / हमारा बजाज”

देशातील आघाडीचा उद्योग समूह असलेल्या बजाज उद्योग समूह (बजाज ग्रुप) नावारूपाला आणणारे जेष्ठ उद्योगपती राहुल बजाज यांचे १२ फेब्रुवारीला निधन झाले. बजाज हा शब्दच मुळी रूबाबदार बनवणाऱ्या या जबरदस्त व्यक्तिमत्वाने फक्त औद्योगिक जगालाच नव्हे तर सर्व देशावरच आपली छाप सोडली आहे. बजाज समूहाला आजचे यश, भव्यता आणि हा दिमाख मिळवून देण्याचे श्रेय राहुल बजाज यांनाच द्यावे लागेल. श्रीमंती, दिमाखदार, किर्ती या शब्दांना पर्यायी शब्द म्हणजे बजाज बनवण्यात राहुल बजाज यांचा सिंहाचा वाटा आहे. आपल्या कर्तृत्वाने राहुल बजाज यांनी फक्त बजाज समूहाचे रूपांतर मोठ्या औद्योगिक (जगतालादेखील) साम्राज्यात केले असे नव्हे तर त्यांनी औद्योगिक जगताला देखील वेळोवेळी दिशा दाखवली. त्यांच्या या जबरदस्त प्रवासाबद्दल जाणून घेऊ या.

राहुल बजाज यांचे वडील कमलनयन बजाज यांनी १९४२ मध्ये बजाज समूहाची जबाबदारी सांभाळली. कमलनयन यांनी बजाज ऑटोची (इरक्षरक्ष ऑीं) सुरुवात केली. राहुल बजाज १९६८ मध्ये बजाज ऑटोचे सी.ई.ओ. बनले. त्याआधी त्यांनी १९५८ मध्ये दिल्लीतील सेंट स्टीफन्स कॉलेजमधून पदवी प्राप्त केली आणि बॉम्बे विद्यापीठातून कायद्याची पदवी देखील मिळविली. त्यानंतर त्यांनी अमेरिकेतील हार्वर्ड बिझनेस स्कूलमधून एम.बी.ए. केले. राहुल बजाज डेप्युटी जनरल मॅनेजर म्हणून त्यांच्या वडिलांच्या गटाचा एक भाग बनले. ते कंपनीतील मार्केटिंग, अकाउंट्स, खरेदी आणि ऑडिट यांसारख्या महत्वाच्या विभागांची जबाबदारी सांभाळत होते. बजाज ऑटोचे मुख्य कार्यकारी अधिकारी नवल के फिरोदिया यांच्या मार्गदर्शनाखाली राहुल बजाज यांनी व्यवसायातील बारकावे जाणून घेतले, नंतर फिरोदिया आणि बजाज वेगळे झाले.

१९७२ मध्ये वडिलांचे निधन झाल्यावर राहुल बजाज यांची बजाज ऑटोचे व्यवस्थापकीय संचालक म्हणून नियुक्ती करण्यात आली. त्यांच्या नेतृत्वाखाली कंपनीची प्रचंड वाढ झाली. राहुल बजाज यांनी १९७० आणि ८० च्या दशकात ह्या कंपनीची जोमाने प्रगती केली. बिलियन -डॉलर क्लबमध्ये आपल्या कंपनीचा समावेश होण्यासाठी त्यांनी कंपनीचा

महसूल वाढवला. त्यांच्या पुढाकारानेच चेतक आणि बजाज सुपर मॉडेल भारतीय बाजारपेठेत नावारूपास आले. मूलतः इटालियन व्हेस्पा स्ट्रिंटर आधारित, (चेतक) हे लाखो भारतीयांसाठी अनेक दशकांपासून परबडणारे वाहतुकीचे साधन होते आणि त्यांना 'हमारा बजाज' म्हणून स्मरणात ठेवले आहे.

दोन दशकांपूर्वी इतर ऑटोमोबाइल कंपन्यांनी आघाडी घेतल्यावर बजाज ऑटोची विक्री घटली होती. मात्र राहुल बजाज यांनी परिस्थिती ओळखत कंपनीला पुन्हा सावरले. काळानुरूप त्यांनी बजाज समूहात बदल केले. यासाठी २००८ मध्ये, त्यांनी बजाज ऑटोचे तीन युनिट्समध्ये विभाजन केले- बजाज ऑटो, फायनान्स कंपनी बजाज फिनसर्व्ह आणि एक होल्डिंग कंपनी. त्याची मुले आता कंपनीचे दैनंदिन व्यवहार सांभाळत आहेत. राहुल बजाज हे कॉन्फेडरेशन ऑफ इंडियन इंडस्ट्री (उज्ज्व) आणि सोसायटी ऑफ इंडियन ऑटोमोबाइल मॅन्युफॅक्चरर्स (डब्ल्यूअच) चे अध्यक्ष होते. ते अखेरपर्यंत बजाज समूहाचे मानद चेअरमन होते.

१९८६ मध्ये त्यांची इंडियन एअरलाइन्सचे अध्यक्ष म्हणून नियुक्ती करण्यात आली आणि २००१ मध्ये त्यांना पद्मभूषण पुरस्काराने सन्मानित करण्यात आले. जून २००६ मध्ये राहुल बजाज यांची महाराष्ट्रातून राज्यसभेवर निवड झाली. २००५ मध्ये त्यांनी अध्यक्षपदाचा राजीनामा दिला, त्यांचा मुलगा राजीव बजाज ग्रुपचा व्यवस्थापकीय संचालक झाला. २०१३ मध्ये, बजाज परिवाराने 'डिस्टिग्विश्ड फॅमिली ऑफ द इयर' पुरस्कार जिंकला. लोकहितासाठी त्यांची संपत्ती आणि वेळ समर्पित केल्याबद्दल त्यांना हा पुरस्कार मिळाला. बजाज कुटुंब अनेक सामाजिक कार्यांमध्ये सहभागी आहे. बालवाडी, व्यावसायिक आणि तांत्रिक प्रशिक्षण संस्था यासारख्या शाळा ते चालवत, ज्यामध्ये आयटीआय दत्तक घेणे समाविष्ट आहे. ते ग्रामीण महिलांना टेलरिंग आणि भरतकामाचे प्रशिक्षण देत. त्यांनी जानकीदेवी बजाज ग्राम विकास संस्थेच्या छत्राखाली रूग्णालये आणि ग्रामीण विकास कार्यक्रम उभारले आहेत.

उद्योग विश्वात राहुल बजाज हे राष्ट्रहिताच्या किंवा कॉर्पोरेट भारताच्या (ऑर्गॅनिसा खपवळर) समस्यांचे प्रतिनिधित्व करताना रोखठोक बोलणारा आणि दबाव न जुमानणारा माणूस म्हणून ओळखले जातात. राहुल बजाज एकदा म्हणाले होते की 'त्यांचा जन्मच

प्रस्थापिताविरोधी' होता. राहुल बजाज हे त्यांच्या साधेपणाबद्दलही प्रसिध्द होते. तर मित्र परिवारात त्यांना 'निर्भय' म्हटले जायचे. १९७० च्या दशकात, जेव्हा इटलीच्या पियाजिओने बजाजच्या परवान्याचे नूतनीकरण केले नाही, तेव्हा त्यांनी चेतक आणि सुपर सारख्या नावासंह स्वतःच्या स्कूटरच्या ब्रँडचे उत्पादन करण्यास सुरूवात केली. औद्योगिक विश्वाशी निगडीत समस्या असो की देशातील विविध मुद्दे असोत की कोणताही विषय असो राहुल बजाज हे आपले मत निर्भीडपणे, रोखठोक शब्दात मांडत असत.

राहुल बजाज यांच्याकडे बजाज ऑटोमध्ये १०%, बजाज फिनसर्व्हमध्ये १०% आणि बजाज होल्डिंग्ज अँड इन्व्हेस्टमेन्ट मध्ये २४% मालकी हिस्सा आहे. त्यांच्याकडे बजाज फायनान्समध्ये २०% आणि इन होम अप्लायन्समध्ये १४% हिस्सा आहे. त्यांची एकूण संपत्ती ४.४ अब्ज डॉलर एवढी असल्याचा अंदाज आहे. फोर्स इंडियाच्या २०१९ मधील १०० सर्वात श्रीमंत व्यक्तींच्या यादीनुसार, बजाज कुटुंबाची एकूण संपत्ती ९.२ अब्ज डॉलर इतकी आहे आणि बजाज कुटुंब भारतातील ११ वे सर्वात श्रीमंत कुटुंब आहे. पुणे ते औरंगाबाद दरम्यान आज जी सुबत्ता दिसते, त्यात राहुल बजाज यांचा मोठा वाटा आहे. केवळ राज्यच नव्हे, तर संपूर्ण देशाच्या औद्योगिक विकासात त्यांच्या वाटा होता.

त्यांचे सामाजिक योगदानही फार मोठे आहे. भारताच्या विकासासाठी दूरदृष्टी ठेवून सकारात्मक काम करणारे, आव्हानांशी मुकाबला करण्याची प्रेरणा देणारे राहुल बजाज यांच्या कर्तबगारीचे तेजोवलय भारतीय क्षितीजावर अनेक वर्षे तळपत राहिल, हे मात्र खरे. त्यांनी त्यावेळेस व्यक्त केलेले परखड, चिंतनीय विचार आणि दिशादर्शक वैचारिक भूमिका आजही आम्हाला आठवते, आणि आठवत राहणार. अशा या प्रेरणादायी व्यक्तिमत्त्वाला भावपूर्ण श्रद्धांजली!

कविवर्य वसंत बापट व्यक्तित्व आणि कवित्व



वसंत बापट, मंगेश पाडगावकर आणि विं.दा. करंदीकर यांनी मराठी मनांवर काव्यवाचनाचे संस्कार केले. त्यामुळे कविता घराघरांत पोहोचली आणि लोकप्रियही झाली. या तिघांच्या स्वरचित कवितांचा बाज एकमेकांपेक्षा खूप वेगळा होता. त्यांच्या कवितांचा रंगही वेगळा होता आणि सादरीकरणाचा ढंगही वेगळाच होता. कविवर्य वसंत बापट यांच्या मते, कविता ही उद्गार असते, कविता ही छापायची असते. सोयीसाठी, शब्दोच्चारण, स्पष्टउच्चार, व्हॉल्युम याला खूप महत्त्व असते. म्हणूनच सर्व अस्तित्वानिशी कविता सादर करणे हा बापटांचा अत्यंत आवडीचा भाग होता. संस्कृत भाषेचे संस्कार झालेली त्यांची वाणी अतिशय शुध्द होती. लयीच्या अंगाने जाणारे त्यांचे काव्यवाचन आजही अनेकांना स्मरत असेल. त्यांच्या तोंडून मायकेल अँजेलो येशील येशील येशील, राणी पहाटे पहाटे येशील, दख्खनची राणी इत्यादी कविता आजही रसिकांच्या कानात रुंजी घालत असतील. पुण्यातील रविकिरण मंडळाच्या कवींच्या काव्यवाचनानंतर परत एकदा कवितेचा रंगमंचीय अविष्कार या कवींनी फार ताकदीने सादर केला. कविता त्यांच्याच तोंडून ऐकतांना काही वेगळाच अनुभव श्रोत्यांना देत असे.

वसंत बापट यांचा काही काळ जरी मुंबईत गेला असला तरी ते खरे पुण्याचेच, कारण त्यांची जडण-घडण पुण्यांत झाली. पुणेरी संस्कृतीत त्यांचे व्यक्तित्व घडले. पुण्याच्या नु. म. वि. हायस्कूल आणि एस. पी. कॉलेजचे ते विद्यार्थी. साने गुरुजी, सेनापती बापट, एस.एम.जोशी, ना.ग. गोरे यांच्या विचारधारेचा परिचय त्यांना पुण्यात झाला. पुण्याच्या समृद्ध वैचारिक परंपरेचा त्यांच्या व्यक्तिमत्त्वावर सुयोग्य असा परिणाम झाला आणि या शहराच्या वैचारिक घुसळणीतून त्यांचा पिंड घडला. ते स्वतः एके ठिकाणी म्हणतात, अनुष्टुभ छंद फार जवळचा वाटत होता. तेराव्या-चौदाव्या वर्षी कविता म्हणजे काय याची अंधुक जाणीव व्हायला लागली. या अपरिपक्व अवस्थेतच एक कविता कागदावर उतरली आणि ती सरांना दाखवल्यावर ही कविता तूच लिहिलीस का? असा प्रश्न सरांनी विचारला. पण या प्रसंगामुळे आपण कविता लिहू शकू असा विश्वास त्यांच्या मनात निर्माण झाला. पुढे महविद्यालयात गेल्यावर कविता ही काही तरी चोरून करण्यासारखी गोष्ट आहे असे त्यांना वाटू लागले आणि मग टोपण नावाने आपण कविता लिहू शकतो हे देखील ध्यानी आले. त्यावेळेच्या कवितांत अर्थात प्रेम आणि सौंदर्य हे विषय जिव्हाळ्याचे असावे यात काही नवल नाही. प्रेम आणि सौंदर्य ही बापटांच्या जगण्यातील प्रधान वृत्ती होय. त्याच वेळी त्यांच्या हेही लक्षात आले की, कविता ही कधीही कोणावर लिहिलेली नसते. शंभर ठिकाणंच तिळ-तिळ सौंदर्य एकत्र केल्यावर जे शिल्प तयार होते त्याला कविता म्हणतात. याच वृत्तीतून त्यांची कविता साकारत गेली. कविवर्य बापट यांची कविता विविधरंगी, विविधढंगी आहे. निसर्गाची सुंदर रूप तिच्यात आहे. कविवर्य बापटांचे शब्द, वृत्त, छंद यांच्यावरील पकड विलक्षण होती. बापटांची कविता सामाजिक भान फार समर्थपणे व्यक्त करित होती. १९४२ च्या आंदोलनात त्यांचा सक्रिय सहभाग होता. देशकर्तव्य आणि देशप्रेमाचा वसा त्यांनी घेतला आणि तो प्रेमाने जपला. त्यांच्यावर झालेले राष्ट्रसेवा दलाचे संस्कार फार महत्त्वाचे होते. साने गुरुजींसारख्या संवेदनशील व्यक्तीचा प्रभाव त्यांच्यावर खोलवर उमटून गेला. त्यांना एकदा एस. एम. जोशींचे पत्र

आले, त्यांनी त्यात बारा गाण्यांची मागणी त्यांच्याकडे केली होती. तिथून बापटांच्या कवितेने सामाजिक बांधिलकीने आपल्या लेखनास प्रारंभ केला. त्यातुन त्यांचे सोळा गाण्याचे पुस्तक प्रसिध्द झाले, ज्याला गोपीनाथ तळवळकरांची प्रस्तावना होती.

सेवादलातील बापट हा स्वतंत्र लेखनाचा विषय व्हावा इतके त्यांचे काम मोठे आहे. लीलाधर हेगडे आणि वसंत बापट यांची जोडी तेव्हा गाजली होती. त्याचवेळी त्यांचा शिंग फुकिले रणी हा कवितासंग्रह प्रकाशित झाला. त्यावेळी वसंत दाते यांच्यावर लिहिलेला बापटांचा पोवाडा खूप गाजला आणि त्यांना राष्ट्रकवी हा किताब प्राप्त झाला. इथून बापटांच्या कवितेचे पोवाडा युग सुरु झाले. १९४८ साली त्यांनी महात्मा गांधीवरही पोवाडा लिहिला. ही वाटचाल भारताला स्वातंत्र मिळाल्यानंतर काश्मीरच्या पोवाड्यापर्यंत चालू होती. त्यावेळी सेवादलांच्या बैठकाही बापटांच्या गाण्यांनी सुरु होत असत.

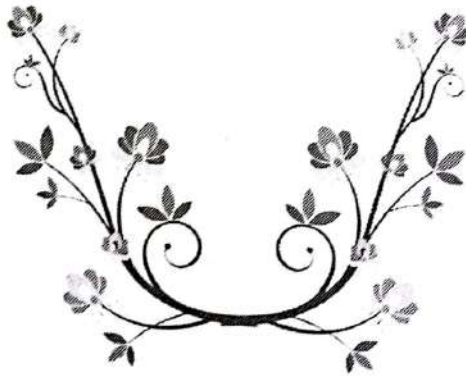
म्हणत डफावर थाप पडली. ९ ऑगस्ट १९८८ ला शूर मर्दाचा पोवाडा हे त्यांचे पोवाड्यावरील पुस्तक प्रसिध्द झाले. त्यात त्यांच्या अत्यंत ओजस्वी आणि जोशपूर्ण कविता अनुभवता येतात. ज्या ज्या वेळी देश संकटात आला, चळवळी झाल्या त्या त्या वेळी बापटांच्या कविता तेजःपुंज होऊन प्रगटलेली दिसते. ब्रीद तुझे विस्मरुनीया सैनिका भागेलका? क्रांती येता पाऊल मागे घेऊनी चालेल का? असा प्रश्न बापट विचारतात. त्यांची कविता एका काळात समुहाची उद्गाती बनली होती. उत्तुंग आमची उत्तरसिमा इंच इंच लढवू किंवा सदैव सैनिका पुढेच जायचे, न मागुती पुन्हा कधी फिरायचे यासारखी गीते अनेकांनी लहानपणी म्हंटलेली आठवत असतील. त्यामुळेच असे म्हणावसे वाटते की, वसंत बापटांनी एक नवी सामुहिक गीत संस्कृती निर्माण केली. त्यांच्या कवितेने शाहिरी परंपरा जपली. संस्कृत साहित्याचे ऋण त्यांच्या कवितेने मनोमन जपले. त्यांच्या कवितेची जातकुळी पंडिती कवितेची आहे. १९४२साली त्यांनी भूमीगत आकाशवाणी केंद्र सुरु केले होते. ट्रॅकेत बसवलेल्या ट्रान्समीटरवरून ते प्रसारित होत असे. एका एका स्वदेश हितरत, नभोवाणी हि स्वतंत्र भारत, मधुमालती आमटे यांचे हे गीत तेव्हा फार गाजले होते.

सेवादलात असतांना शिस्त आणि सेवा या दोन्हीचे बाळकडू त्यांना मिळाले आणि मग लोकरंजनातून जागृती ही विचारधारा सुरु झाली आणि महाराष्ट्र शाहीर कलापथकाची सुरुवात झाली, त्यांचे नेतृत्व वसंत बापट करीत होते. खूप भ्रमंती केलेला हा कवी होता. ज्या ज्या बाजूला जिकडे जिकडे जावं वाटलं, तिकडे मी गेलो. देश हिंडलो. देश उघड्या डोळ्यांनी बघितला. उघड्या कानांनी सर्व ऐकले. मनात साठवले असे ते म्हणतात. त्यातून त्यांच्या कवितेत नाना छंद वृत्ते आली. महाराष्ट्राच्या जन्माच्या वेळी त्यांनी महाराष्ट्र दर्शन हा कार्यक्रम केला आणि

यशवंतरावांनी तो कार्यक्रम देशभर नेला मग 'भारत दर्शन', 'गोमंतक दर्शन', 'आजादी की जंग' असे अनेक कार्यक्रम त्यांनी सादर केले. त्यावेळी त्यांच्या संघटन कौशल्याची आणि योजकतेची प्रचीती आली. 'तेजसी' या कवितासंग्रहानंतर १९५७ साली त्यांचा 'सेतू' हा कवितासंग्रह आला. त्यांची कविता चोहोबाजूंनी विस्तारायला लागली, ती लक्षणीय झाली. अनेक लहान लहान गोष्टी कवितेचा विषय बनल्या. १९७७ साली त्यांचा 'मानसी' हा मालिका कवितासंग्रह आला आणि असे जाणवले की हा कवी अतिशय तरल संवेदनाही समर्थपणे मांडत आहे. त्यांनी लहान मुलांसाठीही कवितालेखन केले. अनेक वर्षे साधना चे कुशल संपादनही त्यांनी केले. त्यांनी लिहिलेली विसाजीपंतांची बखर हे फार महत्वपूर्ण लिखाण आहे. त्यामुळेच एस. एम. जोशी यांनी म्हटले होते. आमचं व्यक्तिमत्व मांडासारख आहे, वसंताच व्यक्तिमत्व अनेक बाजूंनी फूटलेल्या डेरेदार वृक्षासारखं आहे, पण बापट स्वतः असे म्हणत की, मी संपूर्ण कवी आहे. माझ्या डोक्यावर जर कोणी झोपेत पाणी ओतले तर मी म्हणेन मी कवी आहे. शेवटच्या श्वासापर्यंत कविता मला सोडून जाणार नाही, असा विश्वास असणारा हा कवी आपल्यासाठी निरोपाची लावणी मागे ठेवून गेला.....

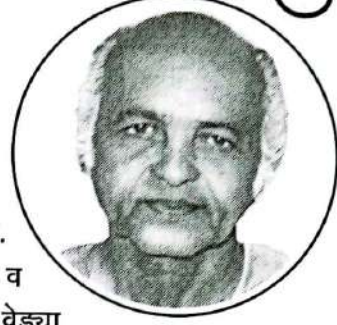

लोककवी वामनदादा कर्डक

त्यक्ती आणि वाङ्मय



लोककवी वामनदादा कर्डक म्हणजे आंबेडकरी विचारांचे सर्जनशील वादळ. त्यांनी त्यांच्या काव्यप्रतिभेने आणि पहाडी आवाजाने त्यांचे प्रेरणास्त्रोत व उद्धारकर्ते अशा बाबासाहेबांचा सांगावा खेड्या-पाड्यात पोहचवला. त्या ध्येय वेड्या भीमशाहिराने त्यांचे सर्व आयुष्य आंबेडकरी चळवळीसाठी वेचले. भीम कार्याची महती जगाला सांगितली. वामनदादा कर्डक यांचा जन्म १५ ऑगस्ट १९२२ ह्या दिवशी झाला. त्यांचा जन्म नाशिक जिल्ह्याच्या सिन्नर तालुक्यातील देशवंडी या खेड्यात झाला. त्यांच्या वडिलांचे नाव तबाजी कर्डक, आईचे नाव साईबाई होते. त्यांचा मोठा भाऊ सदाशिव तर धाकटी बहिण सावित्री. लहान वामन गुरे-ढोरे सांभाळायचा. गावचा संबंध तो तितकाच, कारण वयाच्या दहाव्या वर्षी वामनराव आई-वडिलांसोबत मुंबईस आले. गावी जी तुटपुंजी शेती होती त्यावर कुटुंबाचा चरितार्थ चालणे मुश्किल होते. त्यांचे बालपण गरिबीत आणि खडतर अशा परिस्थितीत गेले.

वामन तबाजी कर्डक नावाने प्रसिद्ध, हे मराठी शाहीर, कवी आणि आंबेडकरी चळवळीतील कार्यकर्ते होते. त्यांच्या हयातीतच त्यांचे चार काव्यसंग्रह प्रकाशित झाले होते. कर्डकांनी डॉ. आंबेडकरांवर १०,००० हून अधिक गीते रचली आहेत. लोकशाहीर वामन कर्डक यांनी डॉ. आंबेडकरांचे विचार आपल्या ओजस्वी वाणीतून, समर्थ लिखाणातून महाराष्ट्राच्या घरांघरांत, खेड्यापाड्यात, वाडीतांड्यात पोहचवण्याचे काम केले. बुद्ध, फुले, आंबेडकर यांचा विचार हा वामनदादांचा श्वास होता, उर्जाकेंद्र होते. हे विचार प्रभावीपणे प्रसारीत करत वामनदादा जीवनाच्या शेवटापर्यंत फिरत राहिले त्यामुळे समाज जागृत होत राहिला.

प्रारंभिक जीवन :-

वामन कर्डक यांचा जन्म १५ ऑगस्ट १९२२ साली नाशिक जिल्ह्याच्या सिन्नर तालुक्यातील देशवंडी या खेड्यात झाला. त्यांच्या परिवारात आई, बाबा, मोठा भाऊ आणि धाकटी बहिण ऐवढे सदस्य होते. त्यांच्या घरी १९ एकर शेती होती. धान्य घरात यायचे तरीही हंगाम संपला की आईने डोंगरावर जाऊन लाकडे गोळा करून मोळी बांधून ते जळतण सिन्नर बाजारात विकायचे. वडील टेंभुर्णीच्या पानाच्या बिड्या करून विकायचे व हेडीचा धंदा करायचे. सर्वांनी कष्ट केल्यावरही आषाढ, श्रावणात आबाळ व्हायची. कधी तरवट्याची भाजी, माठाची भाजी, कधी भाकरीच खावी लागायची. कर्डकांनी लहानपणी गुरे चारणे, जत्रेत कुस्त्या खेळणे, शिवडी येथे गिरणी कामगाराची नोकरी करणे, मातीकाम, सिमेंट क्राँक्रीटचे काम, चिक्की वळणे, आईसफ्रुट विकणे, खडी फोडणे, टाटा ऑईल मिलमध्ये नोकरी इत्यादी कामे केली. त्यांना वाचनाचा छंद होता. तसेच त्यांनी लल्लाट लेख या नाटकात घुमा या पात्राची भूमिका केली होती. वयाच्या २० व्या वर्षी वामनचे लग्न अनुसया नावाच्या मुलीशी झाले. पुढे त्यांच्या कुटुंबात मीरा नावाच्या मुलीने जन्म घेतला. वामनदादांचे जीवन सुखात गेले नाही. बायको त्यांना सोडून गेली आणि पुढे आजारपणात त्यांच्या मुलीचे म्हणजेच मीराचेही निधन झाले. हा त्यांच्या जीवनातला फार मोठा धक्का होता. ते मीराचे दुःख कधीही विसरू शकले नाहीत.

मुंबईला प्रयाण :-

मुलगी मीराच्या निधनानंतर पुढे आईसोबत पोटाची खळगी भरण्याकरिता वामन दादा मुंबईत आले. त्यांनी

गिरणी कामगार म्हणून काम केले. कोळशाच्या वखारीत कोळसा उचलला. चिक्की विक्रीचा, आईस फ्रुट विक्रीचा धंदा केला. मिळेल ते काम केले. नंतर त्यांना टाटा कंपनीत नोकरी मिळाली. शिवडीच्या बिहीडी चाळीत राहत असतांना ते समता सैनिक दलात सामील झाले. इथपर्यंत वामनदादांना अक्षरांचा परिचय नव्हता. एकदा त्यांच्या चाळीमधील एका माणसाने वामनदादांना पत्र वाचायला सांगितले. दादांना वाचता-लिहिता येत नव्हते याचे त्यांना खूप वाईट वाटले. शिक्षण नसल्यामुळे आपण वाचू-लिहू शकत नाही हे त्यांना अवघड वाटू लागले व ते रडू लागले आणि ते देहलवी नावाच्या मास्तरांकडून बांराखडी, मुळाक्षरे शिकले. ते दुकानाच्या पाट्या जोडाक्षरे बोर्ड वाचून शिकले. हळू-हळू त्यांचे लेखन वाचन वाटू लागले. सोबतच ते विविध खेळही खेळायचे व व्यायाम करायचे.

आंबेडकरी चळवळीत सहभागी :-

त्यावेळी आंबेडकरी चळवळ सर्वत्र वेगाने जोर धरू लागली. आंबेडकरांचे अनुयायी समतेच्या लढ्यात उतरले होते.

वामनदादाही बाबासाहेबांच्या सभेला जात. समता सैनिक दलातील तरुणांसोबत काठीला काठी लावून बाबासाहेबांना सभास्थानी जायला रस्ता करून देत. नायगाव येथे १९४२ साली वामन कर्डक यांनी बाबासाहेबांना पहिल्यांदा पाहिले हाते.

कवी :-

वामन कर्डक यांचे मराठी व हिंदी वाचन बरेच पुढे गेले होते ते अनेक चित्रपट, कंपन्यांमध्ये गेले होते. पण त्यांना मिनर्व्हा फिल्म कंपनीत एकदा म्हणून प्रवेश मिळाला. ते कारदार स्टुडिओ, रणजीत यांमध्ये कामाला जायचे जेव्हा काम नसेल तेव्हा राणी बागेत तासनतास बसायचे.

असेच १९४३ मध्ये राणी बागेत असता वामनदादा कर्डक यांना पहिले हिंदी गीताचे विडंबन गीत करायचे सुचले व ते त्यांनी ३ मे १९४३ रोजी चाळीतील लोकांसमोर गाऊन दाखवले. लोकांनी प्रशंसा केली, टाळ्या वाजवल्या आणि वामन कर्डक कवी झाले.

त्यानंतर २००४ पर्यंत कर्डकांनी गीतलेखनाचा व गायनाचा कार्यक्रम चालू ठेवला. त्यांची प्रकाशित आणि अप्रकाशित मिळून साधारणतः दहा हजारांवर गीतरचना आहेत. त्यांनी काही चित्रपट गीतेही लिहिले आहेत. त्यानंतर चाळीसगांव, मनमाड, टिळकनगर येथे आंबेडकरांच्या भाषणांच्या दरम्यान कवितांचे गायन केले.

'आंबेडकरी चळवळीच्या प्रचार आणि प्रसारासाठी आपले उभे आयुष्य वेचणारे लोककवी वामनदादा कर्डक यांचे १५ मे २००४ रोजी निधन झाले . वामनदादांची पाहाडी आवाजातील लोकगीते हजारांचा जनसमुदाय ऐकतांना दिसतो. ही किमया केवळ त्यांच्या आवाजाची नव्हे तर आशयाची आहे. दादांची गीते लोकजीवनाचा वेध घेणारी आहेत. त्यामुळे त्यात वक्तृत्वही आले आहे. पण हे वक्तृत्व उसने नाही. ते लोकमनाला थेट भिडणारे आहे. शाळेची पायरी न चढणाऱ्या वामनदादांची ही लोकगीतातील शब्दांची सुसंस्कारित जडण-घडण आहे. लोकगीत हे मराठीचे सौंदर्य मानले जाते तर शाहिरी काव्यामुळे किंवा लोकगीतांमुळे मराठी कवितेचा उषःकाल झाला, असे पेशवेकालीन शाहिरांना वाटलं. मोठ्या प्रमाणात अस्पृश्यता आणि बेरोजगारी व वेठबिगारी वाढली होती. स्त्रियांना या काळात कोणत्याच प्रकारचे सामाजिक स्थान नव्हते. केवळ चुल आणि मुल एवढाच दर्जा होता. युद्धावर अनेक दिवस बाहेर काढणाऱ्या सैनिकांसाठी पेशवाईतील शाहिरांनी स्त्रियांच्या शृंगाराचे भडक वर्णन करणाऱ्या चवचाल लावण्या लिहिल्या. शृंगारिक लावण्या लिहिण्यात अनेक शाहीर अडकले तर सामाजिक चळवळीचा वेध घेऊन लोकगीतकारही याच वेळी समोर आले. त्यात शाहीर अमरशेख, लोककवी वामनदादा कर्डक, लोकशाहीर अण्णाभाऊ साठे आदिंचा समावेश होता. महाराष्ट्रातील लोककवींना समाजमनाची चिंता होती. लोकगीताच्या ६० वर्षांच्या कालखंडात परिवर्तनवादी भूमिका लोकगीतातून व्यक्त झाल्या.

लोकगीतांमधून प्रामुख्याने कष्टकरी, कामगार, शेतकरी, मार्क्सवादी, स्त्रीवादी, दलितांची चळवळ, स्वातंत्र्याची आणि संयुक्त महाराष्ट्राची चळवळ, राष्ट्रवादाचा पुरस्कार आणि प्रामुख्याने माणसांचा आणि माणुसकीचा धर्म वृद्धिंगत करण्याच्या दृष्टिकोनातून प्रयत्न झाले. लोकगीतांतून घडणाऱ्या समाजाचा मूलाधार प्रबोधन हा आहे. समाजातील विषमतेवर कोरडे आहेत. वामनदादा लोकगीतून दाहक वेदना मांडतात. लोककवी वामनदादा हजारो वर्ष या देशात आपल्या झंझावती काव्यशक्ती आणि प्रतिभेने अजरामर आहेत. या महान विभूतीस विनम्र अभिवादन .

मानवता , क्षमता ,बंधुभाव, शील, करुणा, मैत्री या आंबेडकरी भक्ती दलित, शोषित, स्त्रीमुक्ती, जातिव्यवस्था, मनोरंजनातून प्रबोधन या विषयावरही दादांची लोकगीते आजही प्रभावी वाटतात. चळवळीच्या अशा असंख्य गाण्यांबरोबर दादांची पर्यावरण, हुंडाबंदी, ऊसतोड कामगार, दुष्काळ, अशा भिन्न विषयांवर मोठ्या प्रमाणात लेखन केले. संत तुकाराम महाराज यांच्या अभंगरचनेचे मुळ प्रेरणा स्थान जसे विडुल होते, त्याचप्रमाणे लोककवी वामनदादा यांचे गीतरचनेचे मुळ प्रेरणास्थान डॉ बाबासाहेब होते. डॉ बाबासाहेब आंबेडकर या प्रचंड शक्तीने समाजतळ ढवळून निघाला, रुढीचा सहारा करून व आत्मतेजाची पखरण करून समाजरथ पुढे जाऊ लागला.

वामनदादांची गीते चित्रपटातूनही गाजली. वामनदादा कर्डकांची अशी खूपशी गाणी आजही ओठावर ताल धरतात.

शांताबाई शेळके असे म्हटल्यावर आपल्याला त्यांच्यातला कवी आठवतो, त्यांचे व्यासंगी व्यक्तिमत्व आठवते, त्यांची विद्वता आठवते पण त्याही पेक्षा आपल्याला भुरळ घालतात त्या गीतयात्री शांताबाई.

शांता शेळके यांचा जन्म १२ ऑक्टोबर १९२२ रोजी पुण्यातील इंदापूर येथे झाला. त्यांनी आपले प्राथमिक शिक्षण महात्मा गांधी विद्यालय, राजगुरु नगर आणि उच्च माध्यमिक विद्यालय हुजूरपागा, पुणे येथून पूर्ण केले. त्यांनी पुणे येथील एस.पी. कॉलेजमधून पदवी संपादन केली. मराठी आणि संस्कृत विषयातील एम.ए. पूर्ण केले आणि मुंबई विद्यापीठात प्रथम क्रमांक पटकावला. आचार्य अत्र्यांच्या 'नवयुग' मध्ये उपसंपादक म्हणून ५ वर्षे कार्य केले. १९९६ साली आळंदीमध्ये अखिल भारतीय संमेलनाच्या अध्यक्षपदी त्यांनी कार्य केले. त्या एक प्रतिभासंपन्न मराठी कवयित्री, प्राध्यापक, संगीतकार, लेखिका, साहित्यिक आणि पत्रकार होत्या अनुवादक, समीक्षा स्तंभ लेखिका, वृत्तपत्र, सह संपादिका म्हणून देखील त्यांच्या साहित्यात मोलाचा वाटा आहे.

शांताबाई शेळके या सुप्रसिध्द मराठी कवयित्री, गीतकार आणि लघुनिबंधकार होत्या. त्यांच्या कवितांनी आणि त्यावर बनलेल्या गाण्यांनी उभ्या महाराष्ट्राला वेड लावले आहे.

कथा - कादंबरीसह साहित्याच्या सर्व क्षेत्रांत मुशाफिरी करणाऱ्या शांताबाईंच्या नावावर १०० हून अधिक पुस्तके आहेत. शांताबाईंच्या पुस्तकात येउबबू शंभू सारखी बालकविता, पावसाआधिचा पाऊस सारखा ललितरम्य लेख, असे वैविध्य सापडेल....

गीतकार म्हणून त्यांनी जगण्याचा मोठा पट कवेत घेतलाच, पण ललितलेखांतून त्या व्यक्त होत राहिल्या. एक पानी किंवा पाऊसा आधीचा पाऊस सारखे लघुनिबंध संग्रह, किनारे मनाचे हे त्यांच्या निवडक कवितांचे संकलन कालिदासाच्या मेघदूताचा अनुवाद, हायकू, त्यांनी लिहिलेली चित्रपटगिते, त्यांच्या लेखणीतून उमटणारे सामाजिक, सांस्कृतिक स्थित्यंतरांचे पडसाद असे बरेच काही मागे ठेवून त्या गेल्या.

हे सगळ त्यांच वैविध्य पाहिलं कि पुन्हा एकदा जाणवते ते त्यांच शब्दांवर असलेलं प्रेम, त्यांनी कुठला शब्द परका मानलाच नाही, त्यामुळे कुठलीही भाषा असो, कुठलाही शब्द असो त्या शब्दाच्या अंतरंगात डोकावून पाहण्याचा छंद त्यांच्या गीतरचनेतही त्यांनी जोपासलेला दिसतो. शांताबाई शेळके म्हणजे मराठी शारदेच्या मंदिरातील एक अंखड तेवत असलेला नंदादीप.

त्यांच्या बहुमुखी प्रतिभा, त्यांच्या विपूल साहित्यातून आपल्याला सदैव भेटत राहते मग ती त्यांची गीतरचना असेल, त्यांच्या कविता असतील, त्यांचं स्वतः लिहिलेल लेखन अर्थात त्यांच ललित साहित्य असेल आणि त्याचबरोबर त्यांनी वैपल्यांनी केलेले अनुवादही असतील.

मराठी, संस्कृत आणि इंग्रजी भाषेवर सारखचं प्रभुत्व असणाऱ्या अत्यंत व्यासंगी अश्या शांताबाई पण तितक्याच विनम्र सुद्धा म्हणूनच त्यांच्या साहित्यातून ज्या शांताबाई आपल्याला भेटतात, आपल्याशी मैत्री करतात, संवाद साधतात म्हणून त्या नेहमी आपल्या वाटतात.

त्यांच्या विद्यतेविषयी प्रचंड आदर मनात असतानाही ति कुणीतरी आपली म्हणून त्या आजी असावी, जे आपल्या मायेनी पाठीवरून हाथ फिरवून आपलाल्या चातुर्याच्या, शहाणपणाच्या गोष्टी सांगत आहे असे वाटत राहते.

आळंदी इथे संपन्न झालेल्या अखिल भारतीय मराठी साहित्य संमेलनाच्या अध्यक्षपदाचा बहुमान त्यांना देऊन रसिक श्रोत्यांनी, वाचक, साहित्यिकांनी त्यांना सन्मानित करून त्यांचा गौरव केला. आजपर्यंत बोटावर मोजण्याएवढ्याच महिलांना हे भाग्य लाभलं.

शांताबाई शेळके यांचे निधन ६ जून २००२ रोजी झाले. त्यांना अनेक पुरस्काराने सन्मानित केले आहे. तसेच त्यांच्यावर काही पुस्तके प्रकाशित झाले आहेत.
