
Report on MANTHAN 2022-23

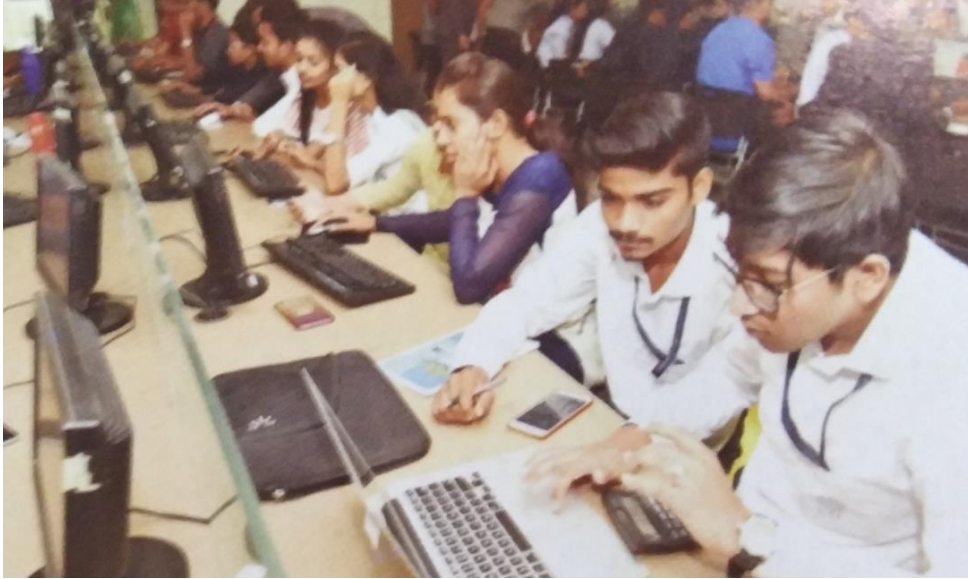

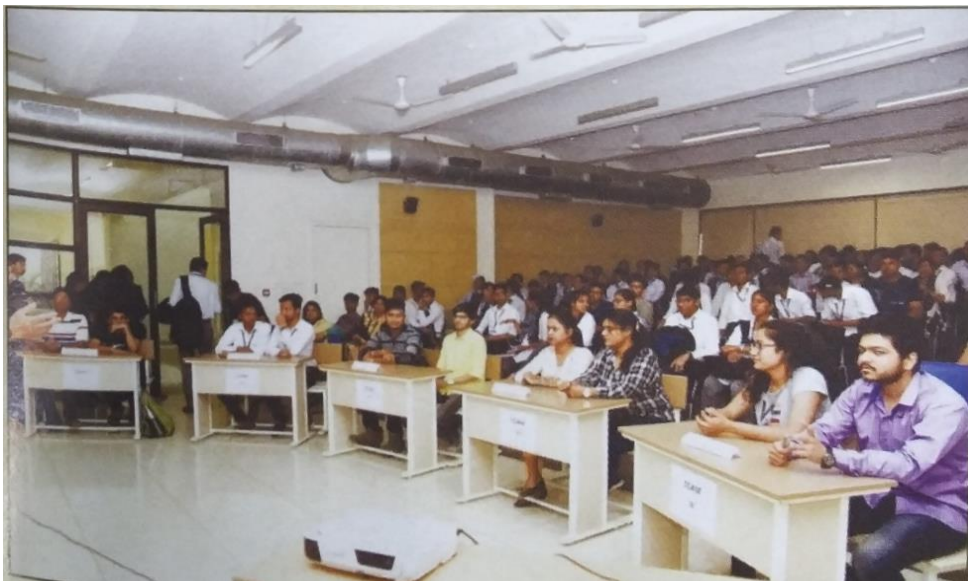
