Subject:- Submission of the report analysis done on the basis of the feedback questionnaire filled by the final year students during the oral examination of the session 2018-19.

Respected sir,

For the overall assessment of the educational facilities and cultural activities provided in the college, the Feedback Questionnaire was filled by the Parent Teacher and Student Exit Feedback Questionnaire Committee in February 2018-19 during the viva voce examination. The following report is being presented on the basis of the analysis. In this process, about 650 students from Grant (B.Com. & M.Com.) and No-Grant (BBA, BCCA, B.COM) departments of the college filled a feedback questionnaire. After studying in detail, it was concluded that each departments feedback is of different type hence the conclusions are drawn for each class on the basis of departments as follows:

Suggestions :-

➤ **M. Com. (Hindi, English, Marathi Medium):-**

- Students praised the behavior of the teachers, guidance, cooperation, teaching methods, activities like guest lectures, discipline, paper presentation, short project work and cooperative personality of all the professors.
- Praising the efforts of the teachers, many students said that due to the cooperation and guidance of the teachers, they have gained confidence in life and learned to solve difficult situations and their communication skills have also enhanced.
- Students wrote three good things about college that 1. Regular Teaching 2. placement 3. library & reference 4. included selection in the volleyball team, NSS(State level & University Level Best Volunteer) etc.
- The innovative method of teaching of the teachers was appreciated by the students.
- Some students gave the credit of selection in various fields to the concerned teachers.
Avishkar, Pune visit, RBI policy challenge, Participated in News Analysis, GS SUN, Attend CROSSWORD Seminars etc. were remarked as beneficial and proud moments for the students.
- Parking, security and campus cleanliness have been appreciated by the students.

Suggestions :-

- The students of all the three mediums of M. Com. have spoken about the shortage of books ; especially the students of Hindi and Marathi medium spoke about the non-availability of Company Law and IDT Books and Notes.

- Students should be taken on an industrial visit.
- For the semester system, the syllabus is very large. If possible, it should be made short and effective as well as employment-oriented and practical.
- English medium professors should be made to teach in English only.
- Internships and articleships should also be started.
- Students (Hindi & Marathi medium) should be given practical and digital knowledge.
- Improvement should be made in the Accounts, Scholarship and Book Issue Department.
- Copies of books of Hindi medium and Marathi medium should be increased in the library.

B.C.C.A. Department :-

- Students praised various things like IT Lab , Teacher Behavior, teaching techniques , Industrial Tour, Guest Lectures, Placement Department, Tech Pro, Aarambh, Nostalgia Farewell, Office Management, Interaction with faculty members.
- Students acquire the qualities of team work, presentation skills, learning skills, stage daring, event management, personality development etc. in the college.

Suggestion:-

- Improvement should be made in computer subjects.
- New market demand technology which are used currently in the market should be introduced in the syllabus.
- Internship programmes should be made mandatory , it helps students to know about the corporate world.
- Practical and employment-oriented knowledge etc. should be given.
- MCA & MCM courses should be started.

□ B.B.A. Department :-

- Students appreciated the teachers' behavior, teaching, excellent academic environment, timely completion of courses, industrial tour, science and technology competition, guest lectures, sports department, and other academic and cultural activities.
- Received prizes in various events, personality development, placement cell, management guru, etc. were appreciated.
- The autonomous curriculum is good, students have benefited by doing it.

Suggestion :-

- Practical knowledge should be given , add it through curriculum and activities.
- Integrate case studies specifically into the curriculum.
- The curriculum is based on theoretical knowledge, some changes should be made in it by adding practical knowledge, case study, project, industry, current affairs, e-learning etc.

- Focus on English communication skills. Students are not having an environment for English communication.
- There should be an industrial tour.

B.Com. No Grant Department

- Students praised the student-faculty relationship, timely completion of courses, placement cell, back etc. value added courses, industrial tours, guest lectures, discipline, teaching techniques, examination, other academic activities and office work style.

Suggestion :-

- In the curriculum, the courses of Accounts, Business Finance and Law subjects should be improved according to modern times and made useful for practical life.
- Students wrote that every teacher should communicate and teach in English as much as possible with the students.
- Attention was also drawn to the problem of washrooms in this department.

● B.Com. Grant (Marathi) :

- Sports Department, N. S. S. Teachers' behavior, teaching, motivational behavior and completion of syllabus on time have been described by students as good.

Suggestion :-

- There should be inclusion of practical knowledge and topics and points of the practical side of life in the curriculum.
- Industrial tours should be organized.
- Banking Account, Financial Account, Income Tax subjects should be included.

B.Com. Grant (Hindi)

- Due to the affectionate, disciplined and cultured personality of the teachers, students' personality has improved even though it is Hindi medium.
- Seeing the concern of the teachers for the bright future of the students, they have realized the importance of education.
- As a result, they are grateful to the principal and teachers of the college.
- Students wrote that they learned how to present themselves to the outside world.

□ Suggestion :-

- Hindi books of Accounts , Marketing , IBL, ECO and ISM are very few in the library. Hindi medium students should also be taught to make PPT and this technique should be used in their teaching as well.
- The blackboard of the class should also be improved.
- Industrial tours should be organized.

□ B.Com. Grant (English Section) :-

- English medium students wrote that due to the specific approach of the teachers, skill development and self-confidence have increased in the students. Due to teachers' guidance they have been able to participate in national level competitions. The placement department has been specially praised.
- The innovative method of continuous teaching of the teachers was appreciated by the students.
- The cultural week 'Umang', quiz competition, G.K. Exam poster competition, inter-college com next, model competition, commerce exhibition, knowledge test and ECA competition were appreciated by the students.
- The students realized their potential while performing responsibilities in various programmes, for which they are thankful to the teachers.
- There are no incidents like gender discrimination or ragging with the students in this college.
- Yoga room, N. S. S. , Sports, and N. C.C. department as excellent.

Suggestion :-

- Water facility should be improved in the Girl' Common room.
- Book issue counters should be done separately for boys and girls in the library.
- There should be a job oriented course.
- Cost-based Xerox and printing facilities should be provided to the students in the college itself.
- The curriculum should be taught digitally.

Common points in all departments: -

Positive and praiseworthy points: -

- According to the students, teachers always show the right way to move forward and help or solve their problems. Their cooperative personality and energetic approach was appreciated by the students.
- The teaching method is very good, interesting and informative.
- All the teachers timely solved the study related problems.
- They have also completed the syllabus on time, doing revision, taking class tests.
- Praising the teaching techniques of the teachers, 70 percent of the students said that they would not take outside tuition.
- According to the students, by coming to this college has helped in personality development, they have realized the importance of education in life, development of learning skills, increased self-confidence and hard work.
- Many girl students told that due to disappointment in life, family or mental problems, cooperation is also provided by interaction the dialogue process of the teachers.
- Counseling done by the women's cell was also told as important and beneficial.
- Parking, security arrangements of the college, cleanliness of the campus were praised.
- Placement Cell, N. S. S., Sports Department, Yoga Room and Library have been appreciated.

- Regarding the three good things, the students have included NSS, library and teaching techniques of teachers.
- In addition to this the cooperative personality, industrial tour, cultural and educational activities in the college - cultural, discipline., Connex, Aarambh, Farewell etc. campus selection, publication of photograph in Rashtradhan, getting rewarded in various activities,. This has helped in boosting the self-confidence and have helped in the all-round development of personality, communication skills due to stage management, victory over fear and increase in self-confidence etc.
- About 50-60 percent of the students are involved in some or the other activity in the college.
- The reasons for not doing PG in college are preparation for competitive exams, search for employment and not being able to meet the standards of attendance, etc.

Suggestions :-

- Quality of food in the canteen should be improved .
- Some good and excellent companies should be invited by the placement cell.
- Standing in long lines throughout the day at the time of examination form or other administrative works.
- Not allowing students to participate in cultural activities due to less attendance.
- Absence of traditional day and prize distribution ceremony in the cultural week in this session.
- Girls Hostel should be started.
- Classrooms should be renovated and made technical.
- There is a need to improve the facilities of sports, ground, gym, etc.
- Wi-fi facility should be provided to the students in the college campus.
- Computer facility should be available in the study room even on Saturdays.
- There should be a door in the toilet of the students.
- Students are dissatisfied with the teaching techniques of many part-time professors.
- Vehicles get damaged in parking lot.
- The classrooms are often not cleaned, there is dust on the benches, due to which the clothes of the students get dirty.
- There should be more than one cash counter, if possible separate for boys and girls.
- The toilets in the Girls' common room should be regularly cleaned and have adequate water facilities.
- Expecting improvement in the accounts of the office department, scholarship department, documents, admission process and inquiry counter, a demand has been made to make separate counters for the students.
- Students who do not go to tuition praise the teaching style of the teachers, but the students who attend the tuition argue that their irregularity in college is due to job or bus. Else they said that tuition are attended by them to do more practice in subjects like accounts and the desire to score good marks.

- Industry oriented course should also be added to the syllabus.
- Bus facility should be started for the students coming from far off places.
- There should be arrangement of a certain room for practicing and changing costumes etc. during the cultural week.
- Students are dissatisfied with the imposition of attendance criteria in every activity of the college.
- In conclusion, in relation to the assessment of the entire activities and facilities of the college, the college has been given grade 'A' by 70 percent students and 'B' grade by 30 percent student

Respected sir,

For the overall assessment of the educational facilities and cultural activities provided in the college, the online Feedback Questionnaire was filled by the Parent Teacher and Student Exit Feedback Questionnaire Committee in 2020-21. This was the first UG batch of autonomy courses started by the college in 2018-19.

The following report is being presented on the basis of the analysis. In this process, about 550 students from Grant (B.Com. & M.Com.) and No- Grant (BBA, BCCA, B.COM) departments of the college filled a feedback questionnaire. After studying in detail, it was concluded that each departments feedback is of different type hence the conclusions are drawn for each class on the basis of departments as follows:

- **M. Com. (Hindi, English, Marathi Medium):-**
- There is a lot of difficulty in understanding the practical subject online.

B.C.C. A. Department:-

- AI, Machine learning, Data structure ,Coding language, server study should be included in curriculum.
- Online coding project should be organized .

BBA Department:-

- Teaching mythology should be enhanced, students should be given more opportunities for internship

B.Com. Grant English , Marathi & Hindi Section -.

- According to the students, the lesson course of Direct & indirect tax syllabus is lengthy, if possible it should be improved.
- Arrange industrial tour .

Common Positive and praiseworthy points in all departments:-

- According to the students, they don't take tuition at all, appreciating the efforts of the teachers, they wrote that under the guidance of the teachers, the school is the best. Teachers personally help in case of any kind of problem in studies.

- The students presented Yoga, Umang and GS SUN . Told the activities were excellent.
- Students of all the departments have clearly written that they do not feel the need to take tuition due to the teaching method of the teachers.
- Students of all the departments praised him remembering the education and other cultural activities before covid-19.
- Praising the teaching skills of the teachers and their attitude towards the students, he said that by coming to this college one can understand the importance of education in life due to personality development. In his personality, the seeds of development of learning skills, self-confidence and hard work have been sown.
- Many girl students told that in case of disappointment, frustration and any kind of trouble in life, teachers also help through the communication process. Along with this, students are taught to work in every activity of the college, which develops self-confidence and leadership ability in the students.
- Compared to Rashtrasant Tukdoji Maharaj Nagpur Vidyapeeth, the autonomous course was described by the students as the best. Also, they wrote that this course is similar to that of Delhi University.
- Students got to learn a lot from the autonomous course started in the college in 2018-19. Being the first batch of the autonomous course, there were some difficulties related to the non-availability of the syllabus, but with the continuous efforts of the teachers, the students completed this course of three years happily and also learned many new points.
- In this time of Covid-19, when the teaching work was slow in other colleges, not only the teaching work but also the examination work, assignments etc. were completed in an excellent manner in our college.
- There was a lot of problem in online classes, but the teachers never allowed the classes to stop, our online classes always continued despite network problems.
- Learned a lot of new things and developed mentally and academically in thinking and attitude.
- In online study method, sometimes the student gets late due to network, then some teachers do not even mark the attendance of that day.

- Cash counter should be more than one, if possible separate for boys and girls.
- Demand has been made to make separate counters for the students, expecting improvement in the accounts of the office department, scholarship department, documents, admission process and inquiry counter.

SUGGESTIONS :

- Current online education system is very good but some students live in rural areas where there is network problem. All the teachers should suggest some solutions keeping in mind the problems of the students. Otherwise, sometimes the network affects the attendance and learning of the students.
- Students studying through online study method said that they find it very difficult to study practical subjects like accounts, statistics online.
- Online teaching also has to face many physical problems.

- It was suggested by students to add Financial literacy, IT knowledge, stock market, industrial knowledge & some practical knowledge add in the syllabus of BBA .
- Placement dept. has to be improved .
- Autonomous curriculum is very good but practical studies and activities should also be added to it.
- Make available books in Marathi medium of autonomous course.
- The process of issuing books in the library should be simplified.
- In online study method, sometimes the student gets late due to network, then some teachers do not even mark the attendance of that day.
- Cash counter should be more than one, if possible separate for boys and girls.
- Demand has been made to make separate counters for students, expecting improvement in office department's account, scholarship department, documents, admission process and inquiry counter.

- In this time of Covid-19, when the teaching work was slow in other colleges, not only the teaching work but also the examination work, assignments etc. were completed in an excellent manner in our college.
- Learned a lot of new things and developed mentally and academically in thinking and attitude.

- Need of visual basic application in all the PC.
- Update syllabus of E-Commerce
- Provide updated software in IT Lab
- Choice must be given to students for optional subject.

B.B.A. Department:

- Teaching mythology should be enhanced, students should be given more opportunities for internship
- In curriculum of B.B.A. Financial literacy, IT knowledge, stock market, industrial knowledge & some practical knowledge should be added.
- Decrease the subjects & Syllabus of BBA as it is very vast plz reduce some part .
- Provide some practical & technical knowledge

B.Com. Grant English , Marathi & Hindi Section -.**Suggestions :-**

- Emphasis should be laid on the performance of the students, their power point presentation should be taken.

- Many students praised the efforts of the teachers and said that due to the cooperation and guidance of the teachers, they have learned to solve difficult situations by gaining confidence in life. Their communication skills have also increased. The students wrote about good things that the college conduct like sports activity, open assembly, teachers, placement dept., regular teaching, new uniform, reference, library etc. Innovative teaching techniques of teachers praise by students.
- Some students gave the credit of their achievements to the concerned teachers. (News Analysis, attending cross-word Seminar) etc activities are beneficial for the students. The students take pride in participating. The parking, security & campus cleanliness praise by students

Suggestion:

- According to the three medium of M. Com students, syllabus books and notes are not available in library specially for Hindi and Marathi medium of EDM, CIHR, Statistics and Company Law.
 - Should have inbuilt projector in classes.

Sub: Report of the Parent – Teacher Meeting held on Sunday ,13th January 2019 Sunday.

Respected Sir,

The Parent- Teacher Committee organized a Parent- Teacher Meeting on Sunday, the 13th January 2019 at 10.00 am under your guidance. About 410 parents from both aided and non-aided (B.COM, B.B.A, B.C.C.A, M.Com.) departments of the college participated in this meeting. The following report is being presented on the basis of the feedback form filled in by the parents and the question and answer session held in the meeting.

Purpose:

- The purpose of organizing this meeting was to find opportunities for overall development of the personality of the students with the cooperation of parents & teachers and to solve the problems related to the facilities available in the college and the new courses started. Also, through this meeting, parents will get familiar with the obstacles in the way of development of their children. In this meeting, many parents discussed their child's development and the efforts of the college.
- The parents of the students who were irregular in the first, second and third year of various classes of the autonomous college were invited to know the reason for the absence of the students.
- Parents were made aware of the compulsory attendance of students in the academic session.
- Parents were apprised of the employment opportunities and placement procedures provided to the students by the placement cell in the college.
- The information about the mentorship scheme given the parents. They were assured that they can contact the teachers and the Principal to know the development of their children and the activities going on in the college.

Working method:

Keeping these objectives in view, the committee prepared a list of their irregular students by the various mentor professors and sent messages (S.M.S.) to the parent. The committee and all the mentor professors personally also informed the parents through telephone.

Program Outline:

The IQAC Coordinator, Prof. Pravin Yadao requested the parents to be aware of the academic activities of their children and urged the parents to create a bridge between parents and teachers which would be helpful in the overall development of the students. He also said that in this digital era, students should study online books and make good use of the internet.

He also requested the parents to encourage and mentally prepare the students for these competitions by explaining the expectations of the various companies invited to provide employment opportunities for the students.

Principal Dr. N. Y. Khandait satisfied the queries of the parents by giving accurate answers to the questions asked by the parents and while replying on the question regarding attendance, he said that the college organizes lectures on communication skills, group discussions, computer exams, self-defence campaign for girls, and various activities to enhance their latent qualities. Various

cultural activities are also organized. Along with this, he said that the college has also got the recognition of research centre for PhD work in higher education. He said that the college has always been striving for providing quality education to the students. As a result, from this year the college has got the status of the first autonomous educational institution of the Faculty of Commerce in Nagpur.

Verbal response of parents:

- Parents appreciated Parent-Teacher Meet and hoped that such meetings should be conducted on a quarterly basis.
- The parents thanked the college and Shiksha Mandal, Wardha for imparting quality education and praised the efforts of the professors and teaching methods while appreciating the academic and cultural activities of the college.
- Also appreciating the mentorship program, he said that due to this scheme, they receive periodic instructions from the college teachers about their children, which keeps them informed about their children's activities. Parents called the college's academic activities along with the revision sessions and CGC (Career Guidance Department), a better effort for the students.
- Mr. Waghmare thanked the principal for organizing the parent teacher meeting and the efforts made for the development of the students and appreciated the teachers and teaching methods.
- Ms. Jayashree Bhongade raised a question regarding the facilities for the girl students that the toilet for the girl students is less and the water in the toilet is also less in most cases. The principal said that the college is constantly working in this subject. Girls will have to be careful about hygiene.
- Shri Ram Mishra said that due to the good education system, there was no need for tuition for his children. But some parents said that their children should be tutored for difficult subjects like accounting.

The principal of the college and teachers thanked the parents for attending the meeting saying that the students are stack holders for the quality education provided in the college. Our goal is to create a better future for them.

The feedback form filled by the parents was given by the guardian. The findings are:

- 1) The student-teacher relationship becomes stronger. Communication skills are lacking in students nowadays, so teachers should continuously provide opportunities for communication skills. Also guide them to choose future employment according to their aptitude.
- 2) Arrange a separate designated room for the competitive examination course.
- 3) Improve the office system, office facilities and employee behaviour.
- 4) It was suggested to hold parent-teacher meeting every three months and it was also suggested to hold the meeting in a big hall.
- 5) If the student does not attend the class regularly, then strict action should be taken against him. Also, if possible, parents should be regularly informed about student's attendance and Unit Test results through SMS. But in the first period, the students coming from far away are not able to attend due to the inconvenience of the bus. In many cases students cannot attend due to health-related reasons.
- 6) The parents of the college are aware of the anti-ragging cell etc. and appreciated the college for being a ragging free college.
- 7) Parents wrote that the standard of the college is very good. They were sure of the teachers that teachers would continue to encourage and cooperate with the students in the same way. Copies of books should be made available in large quantities for Hindi and Marathi medium students. B. C. C. A. Course books should be updated in the library.
- 8) Some parents opined that participation in extra-curricular activities should be made mandatory for all students. Interview method, personality development and time planning should be taught to M. Com. students through seminars and workshops.

- 9) Praising the teaching techniques of the college teachers, it was written in feedback form that most of the students do not take tuition and those who take tuition, believe that they go to tuition only to practice in practical subjects and get good marks.
- 10) Cleaning of common rooms and toilets of girl students should be done regularly.
- 11) The parents wrote that due to the Mentorship scheme, they keep getting information about the progress of the ward.
- 12) There must be more Smart classes .
- 13) According to the parents, sometimes students are not able to attend the classes even if they want to, because of job, financial condition, professional course or health.
- 14) Professors of professional courses run in the college should teach in quality manner or if possible some professional teachers should be called from outside.
- 15) Some parents suggested that instead of written unit test, presentation, group discussion etc. should also be conducted.
- 16) The parents appreciated the overall discipline of the college, the alertness and efforts of the teachers.

To conclude from the feedback questionnaire, the findings are that the development of the college, the efforts of the teachers, the regularity of classes, the unit test, the mentor system started for the all-round development of the students, other extra-curricular activities and the Parent-teacher Meet committee work was praised by the parents.

Sub: Report of the Parent-teacher Meet held on Sunday, January 5, 2020.

Respected Sir,

Under your guidance, the Parent-Teacher Meeting was organized on Sunday, January 5, 2020, at 10.00 am. About 275 parents from both the departments of the college - aided and un-aided (B.COM, B.B.A. B.C.C.A, M.Com.) participated in this meeting. The following report is being presented on the basis of the feedback form filled by the parents and the question and answer session held in the meeting.

The objectives

- The purpose of organizing this meeting was to assess the progress of students with the cooperation of parents and teachers and to solve the questions related to the educational environment of the college, the facilities available and the new courses started. At the same time, through this meeting, the parents get acquainted with the obstacles coming in the way of development of their wards. In this meeting many parents discussed about the development of the students and the efforts of the college.
- In the different session of the various classes of the autonomous college, the parents of the irregular students were invited to know the reason for the absence of the students.
- Parents were made aware of the necessity of presence of students in academic session and extra-curricular activities.
- The placement cell in the college made the parents aware of the employment opportunities and process available for the students.
- Giving information about the mentorship scheme to the parents, they were assured that by contacting them, they can continuously know about the progress of their wards and the activities happening in the college.

Working method:

- Keeping these objectives in view, various mentor professors prepared a list of irregular students and submitted to the committee and sent messages (S.M.S.) to the parents. The committee, and all the mentor professors also personally informed the parents through telephone.

Program outline

- The coordinators of various departments called upon the parents to make them aware and conscious about the educational activities of their wards and urged the parents to build a bridge between the parents and the teachers, which would help in the all-round development of the students.
- B. Com. Coordination Dr. Thangan and M. Com. Coordinator Dr. Morey called upon the parents to encourage and mentally prepare the students for various competitions by stating the expectations of the various companies invited to provide employment opportunities to the students.
- Prin. Dr. N. Y. Khandait replied to the queries of the parents by giving appropriate answers to their questions. While replying to a question related to attendance, he said that the college conducts

communication skills, group discussion, computer education, self-defence campaign for girls, to enhance their latent qualities. Different types of cultural activities are also organized but only regular and disciplined students can participate in all these activities. Along with this, he told that the college has also got the recognition of Research Centre for PhD work in higher education. He told that the college has always been in favour of providing quality education to the students. As a result, the college has got the status of the first autonomous educational institution of commerce faculty in Nagpur since last year. So the students should attend the college regularly.

- At the same time, he told that under any circumstances, no college facility can be availed by the students without regularity. From the next year, a new course of Commerce In Honours is also being started in the college.

Oral feedback from parents:

- Parents appreciated Parent-Teacher Meet and hoped that such efforts should be done on a quarterly basis.
- The parents thanked the college and Shiksha Mandal, Wardha for providing quality education and appreciated the academic and cultural activities and praised the efforts of the professors and teaching methods.
- At the same time appreciating the mentor program, parents said that due to this scheme, they keeps getting information about their wards from time to time by the teachers of the college, due to which they keep getting information about the activities of the wards. Along with the academic activities of the college, the parents also called the repetition session and CGC (Employment Guidance Department), as a good effort for the students.
- Mr. Sheikh said that due to the excellent teaching methods, his child does not need tuition. But some parents talked about sending their children to tuitions for difficult subjects like accounts.
- Another parent said regarding the attendance of the first period that the students coming from far off places could not attend the first period due to the inconvenience of the bus, then the principal replied that the attendance of the first period is taken at the end of the period.
- In many cases students cannot attend due to health-related reasons. In this situation, the Principal said that 10 percent attendance on the basis of medical documents is considered.
- Mr. Sharma praised the teachers and teaching methods while thanking the principal for organizing the Parent-teacher meeting and the efforts made for the development of the students.
- Rajshree Jain raised a question regarding the facilities for the girl students namely that there are few toilets for the girl students and there is no water in the toilets. The Principal sir said that the college is making continuous efforts in this regard. The girl students themselves also have to be careful about cleanliness. Along with this, suggestions were also given regarding the cleanliness and safety of the girl's common room.
- In the end, the principal thanked the parents for being present in the meeting and said that these students are our stake holders. This is the goal, for which the co-operation of the parents is expected and essential.

Suggestions given by the parents on the basis of the feedback form filled by the parents:

- 1) Student-teacher relationship should become stronger. Nowadays, there is a lack of communication skills among the students, so teachers should continuously provide opportunities for communication skills to the students. Also guide them to choose future employment according to their qualification.
- 2) Most of the parents wrote to solve the problem of lack of water and toilets.
- 3) It was also suggested to improve and renew the benches and blackboards of the classes.
- 4) The glasses of the windows of many classrooms are broken due to which the students suffer in cold days, so it was suggested to fix them.
- 5) Regarding the suggestion of quarterly parent-teacher meeting by the parents, the principal said that the parents can come and contact the teachers whenever they want after the class time.

- 6) Parents wrote that the overall standard of the college is very good. In future too, the teachers should continue to encourage and cooperate with the students in the same way. Copies of books were made available in large quantities for Hindi and Marathi medium students. The books of the autonomous curriculum should be imported into the library.
 - 7) Some parents believed that participation in extra-curricular activities should be made mandatory for all students. The students should be taught topics like interview method, personality development and time planning through seminars and workshops.
 - 8) Praising the teaching techniques of the college teachers, it has been written in most of the questionnaires that students do not take tuition and those students who take tuition believe that they go to tuition only to practice in practical subjects and get good marks.
 - 9) CA/CPT/CS, CAT, NSS, NCC Camp and the camp at Shiksha Mandal, Wardha should be exempted from the attendance criteria.
 - 10) Students should be taken on industrial trip so that they can get practical knowledge.
 - 11) There should be activities like Job Oriented Education for the students and Self Defence for the girl students.
 - 12) Emphasis should be laid on English Communication for the students in the college, because even the English medium students are not proficient in English language.
 - 13) The professor of Marathi medium should teach in the class only in Marathi language.
 - 14) Girls hostel facility should also be given.
 - 15) According to the parents, sometimes the students are not able to attend the classes even if they want to because dependency of bus, job, financial condition, professional course or health. Many students come late in the morning classes due to night duty.
 - 16) Smart classes should be organized.
 - 17) The parents of the college are aware of the Anti Ragging Cell etc. and appreciated the college for being a ragging free college.
 - 18) The parents appreciated the overall discipline of the college, the alertness and efforts of the teachers.
- To conclude, the academic environment of the college, efforts of teachers, regularity of classes, unit test, mentor system started for all-round development of students, other extra-teaching activities and parent-teacher meeting were praised in the feedback form.

- In the different sessions of the autonomous college, the parents of the irregular students were invited to know the reason for the absence of the students.

- 5) Parents wrote that the standard of the college is very good. In future too, the teachers should continue to encourage and cooperate with the students in the same way.


