

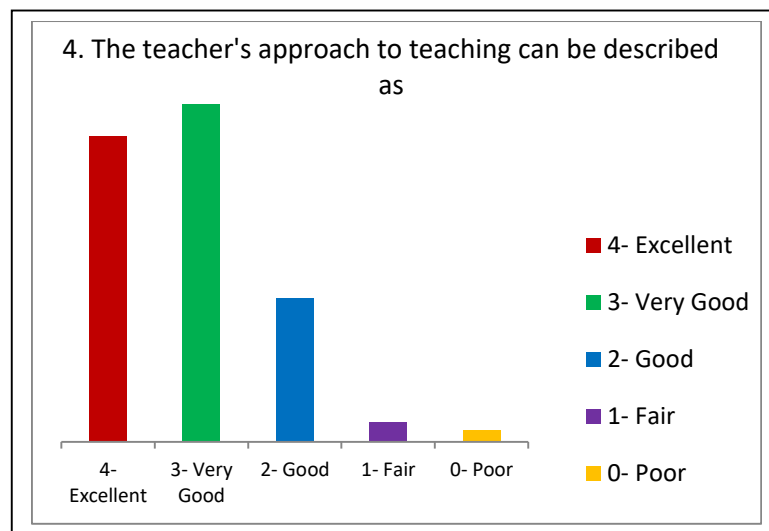
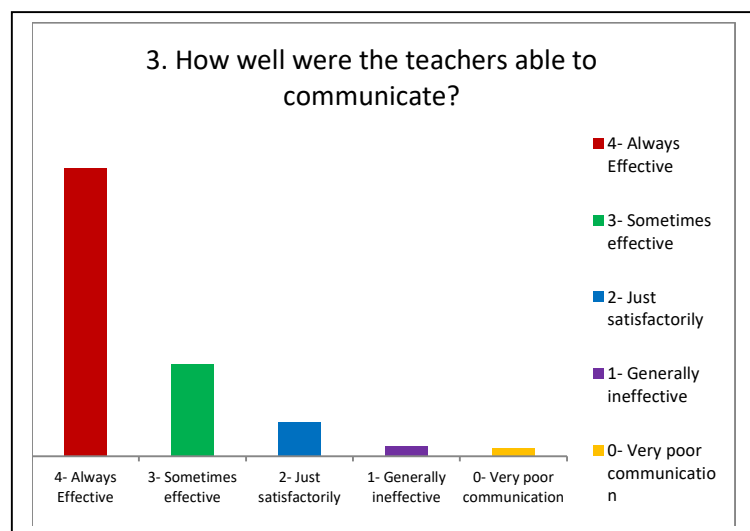
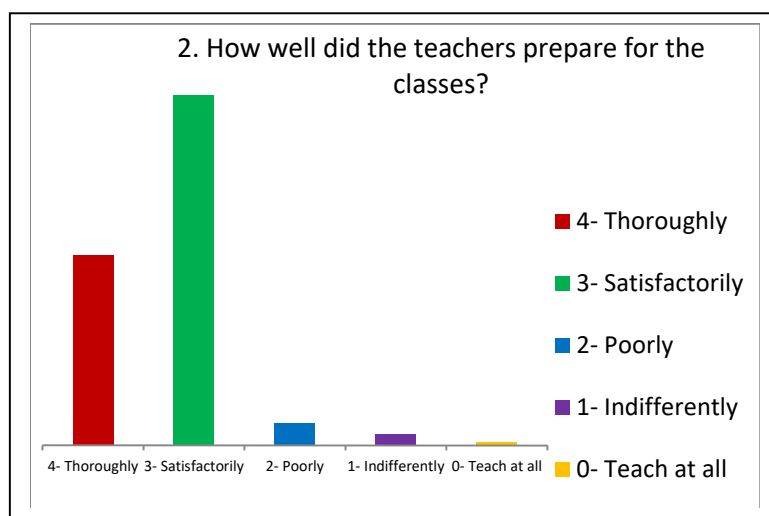
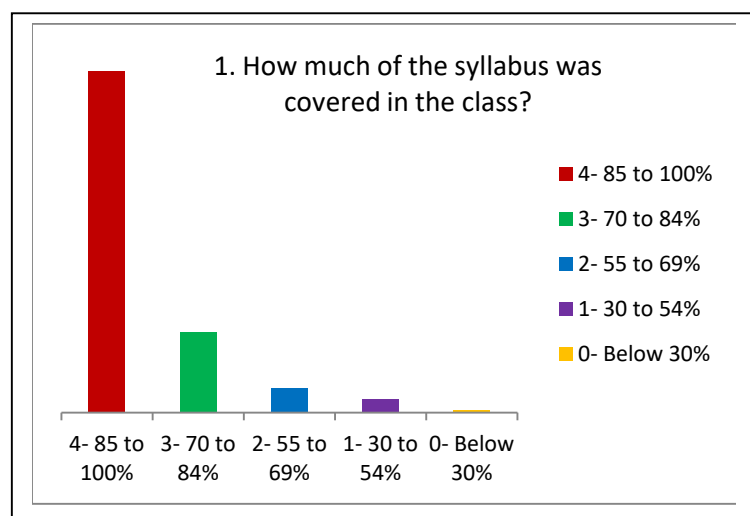
## Report of Student Satisfaction Survey (2.7.1)

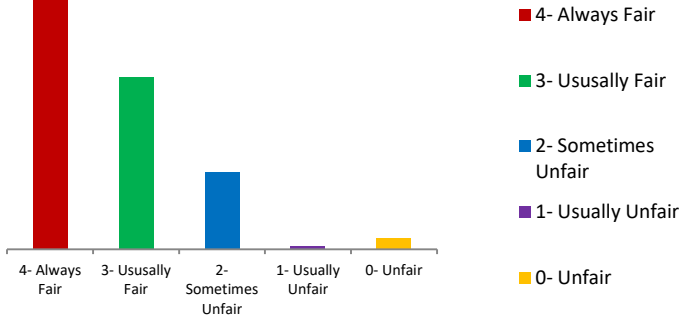

Total 206 duly filled in responses received from U.G. & P.G. students (Autonomy) and have been taken for the purpose of analysis. The results are provided as follows.

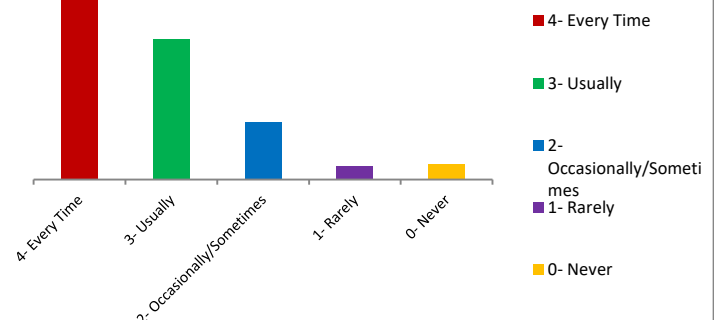
The analysis of question wise responses for first 20 questions is represented in the column chart.



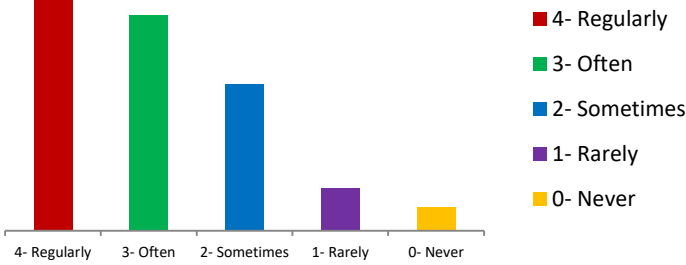
### 5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers.



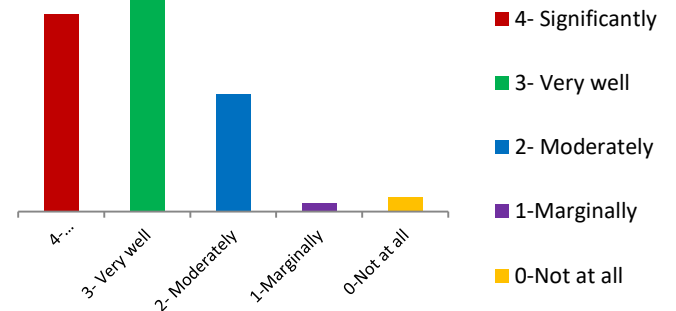
### 6. Was your performance in assignments discussed with you?



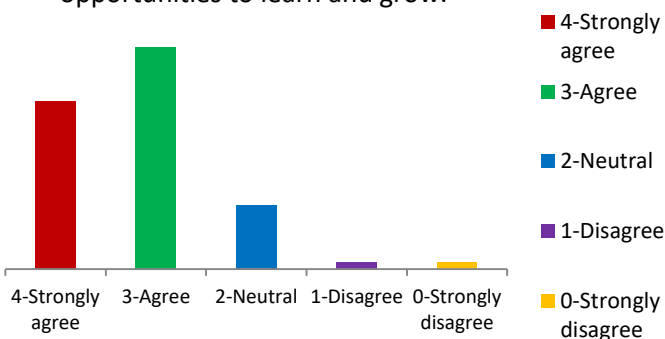
### 7. The institute takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, and field visit opportunities for students.



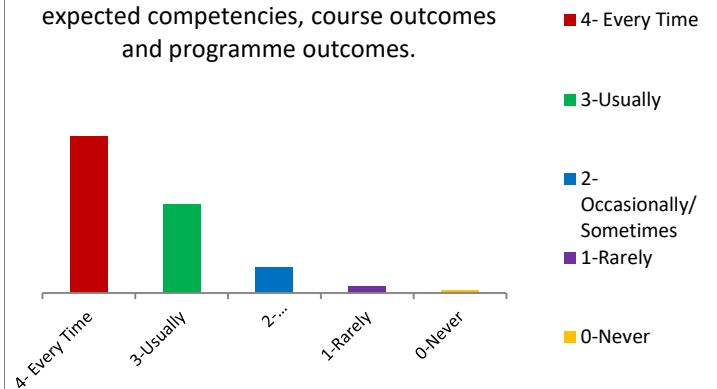
### 8. The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth.



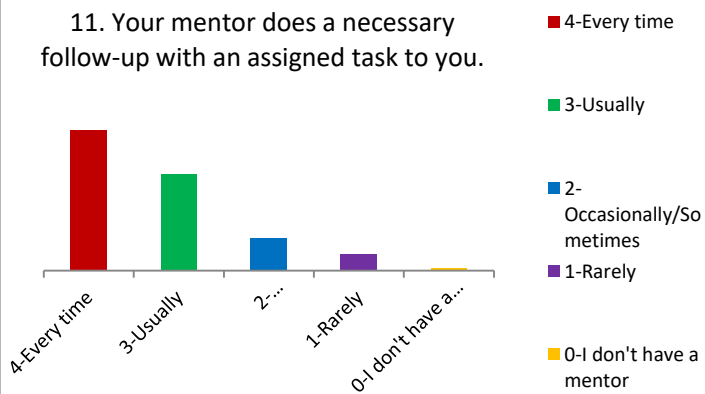

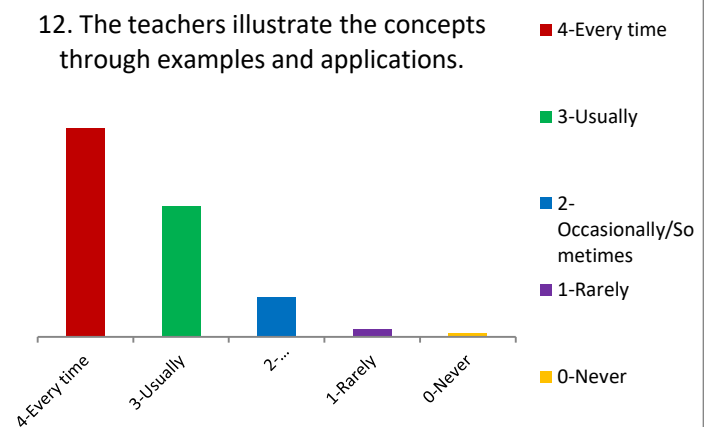
### 10. Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes.



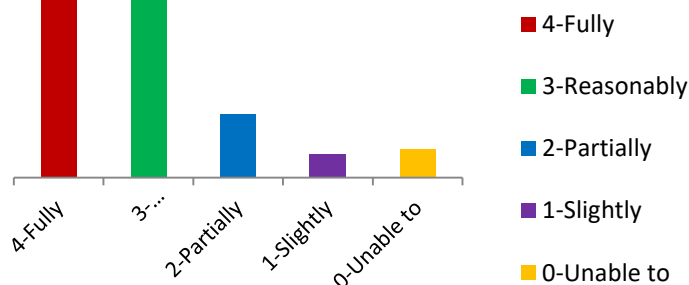
### 11. Your mentor does a necessary follow-up with an assigned task to you.



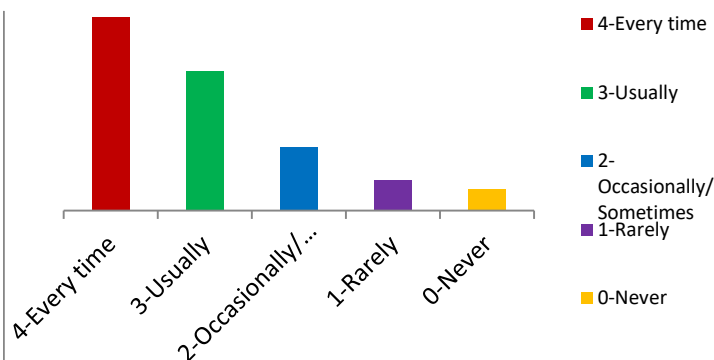
### 12. The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications.



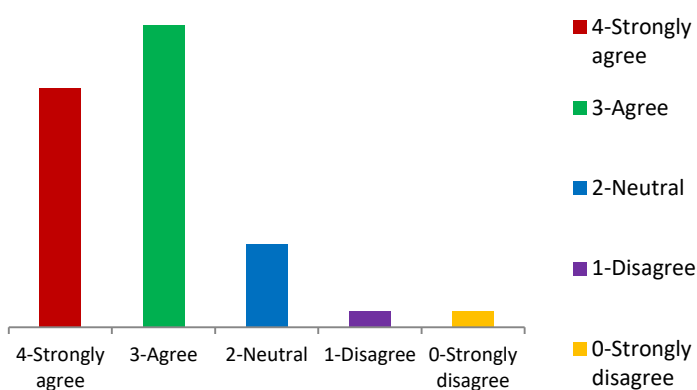
13. The teachers identify your strengths and encourage you with providing right level of challenges.



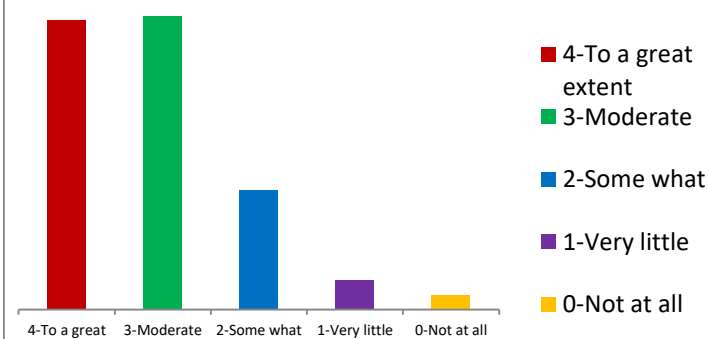
14. Teachers are able to identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome them.



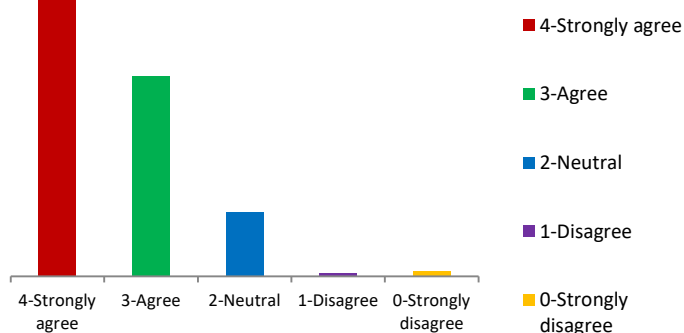

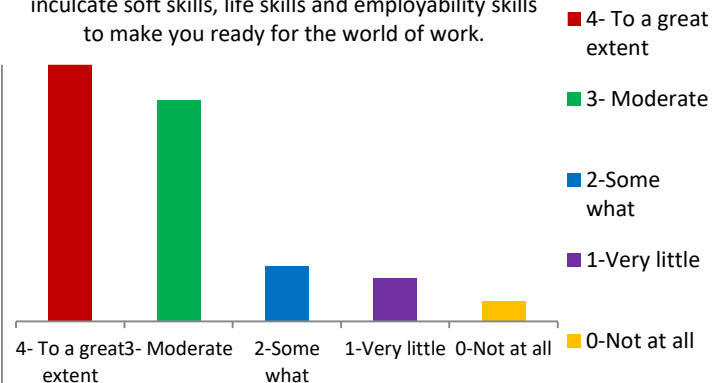
16. The institute/ teachers use student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning



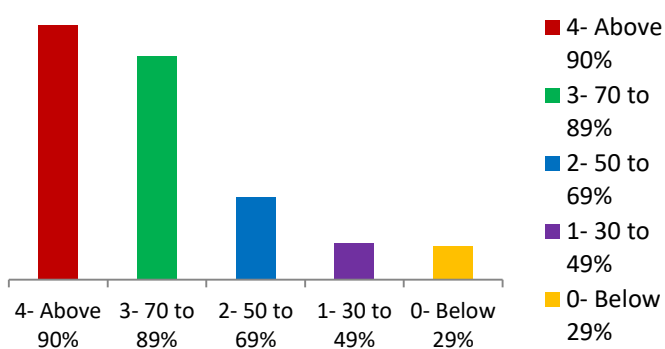
17. Teachers encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities



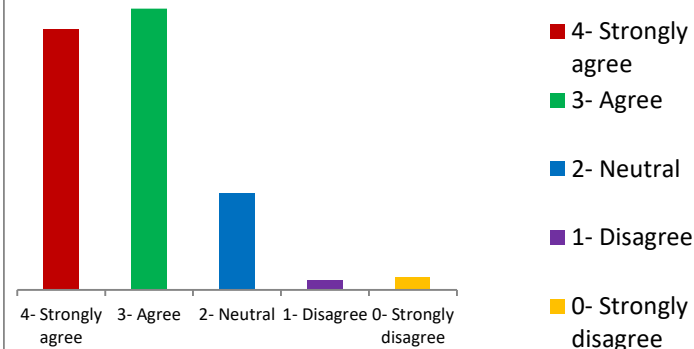
18. Efforts are made by the institute/ teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make you ready for the world of work.
